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B-25s To Be Sold China's Nationalists

WASHINGTON, Nov. 9 (AP)—The state department said yesterday it had given the Chinese Nationalist government permission to buy 11 surplus B-25 bombers for use against the Chinese communists.

Press officer Michael McDermott told a news conference export licenses for the purchase were issued last February and that these planes presumably are the ones now being mentioned in news dispatches.

A Chinese embassy spokesman said yesterday his government had purchased a "few" B-25s which are being readied for delivery. The money for them came from the Chinese government and not from the \$125,000,000 (M) military aid fund which congress appropriated last year for the Chinese nationalists. The fund's money already has been used.

\$18,000 Hangover Suffered
