State Truckers Ask Rate Hike

PORTLAND, Nov. 9 (AP)—Oregon trucking firms asked for a 4 per cent rate boost at a hearing yesterday before the state public utilities commission.

The cargo carriers argued costs had increased to 92.4 per cent of gross revenue the first half of 1949. They said costs should not be above 93 per cent if their net profit is to be fair.

Shippers and carriers' associations indicated they later would oppose the request in arguments that they could not afford higher rates.

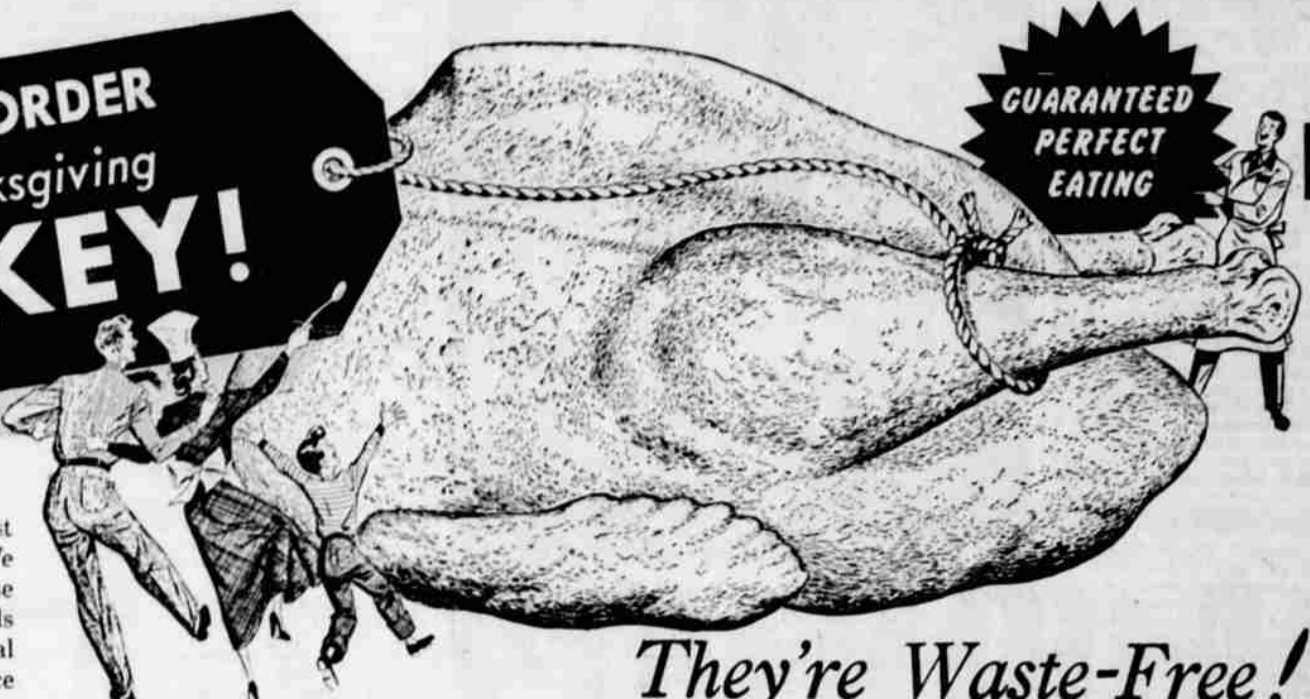
