

PCL DIRECTORS EXTEND SCHEDULE

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 11 (AP)—The Pacific Coast league aims to retain its hold on baseball's marathon title. It will play a 200-game schedule in 1950.

The PCL's directors voted yesterday to:

1. Eliminate the Governor's Cup playoffs, but add two weeks to the regular season, making it a 200 instead of 186-game card.

2. Raise the player limit from 23 to 25, with no limit on veterans or rookies.

3. Distribute \$40,000 to the pennant winning club, with \$20,000, \$12,500 and \$7,500 to other first division teams in that order.

4. Press its petition to the major leagues to be excluded from the draft law.

Nothing was said for publication, anyway—about the proposal to put the PCL champion against the winner of the little world series. Apparently the PCL is going to wait until officials of the American association and international league hash it over.
