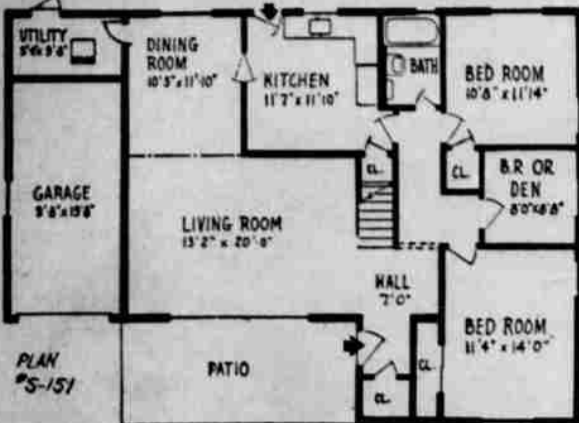
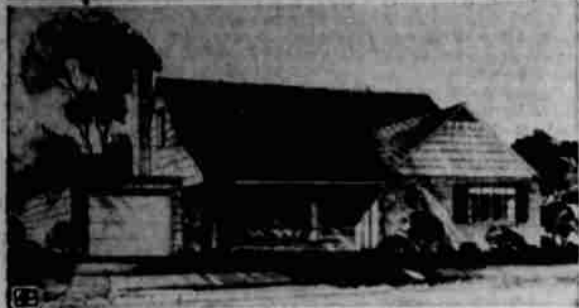


### HOMES FOR AMERICANS



A POPULAR one-story plan with expansion attic, this house packs a maximum of rooms into approximately 1400 square feet by placing the utility room behind the garage. It is planned for basements construction. Tested on Long Island, N. Y., the house created a sensation when 151 orders were signed on the first day it was opened. Built on a 70x100-foot lot, the houses sold for \$13,500 each. This plan, the King Ranch model S-151, was designed by A. H. Salkowitz, architect, 37-60 82nd St., Jackson Heights, N. Y.

### School District Wins \$34,953

SALEM, Nov. 16 (AP)—The U. S. National bank of Portland was ordered yesterday to pay \$34,953 to school district 47 of Columbia county. The supreme court said the bank was responsible for the money, which was embezzled by the district clerk. The clerk made out 118 checks and took the money for his own purposes. The high court said the bank should have known the checks were not valid. The district sued the bank to recover the money. The opinion by Justice J. O. Bailey upheld Circuit Judge Howard K. Zimmerman of Columbia county.

### Portland Needs More Cops

PORTLAND, Nov. 16 (AP)—Wanna be a cop? With promotions and pay boosts and retirement pension? Sounds nice—but the Portland city service board says there are mighty few takers. There are 14 vacancies in Portland police force ranks and within a year another 50 are expected. Only 30 names are on the applicant list. Another examination is slated for Nov. 26 and the board hopes more applicants will show up by November 21, the deadline.

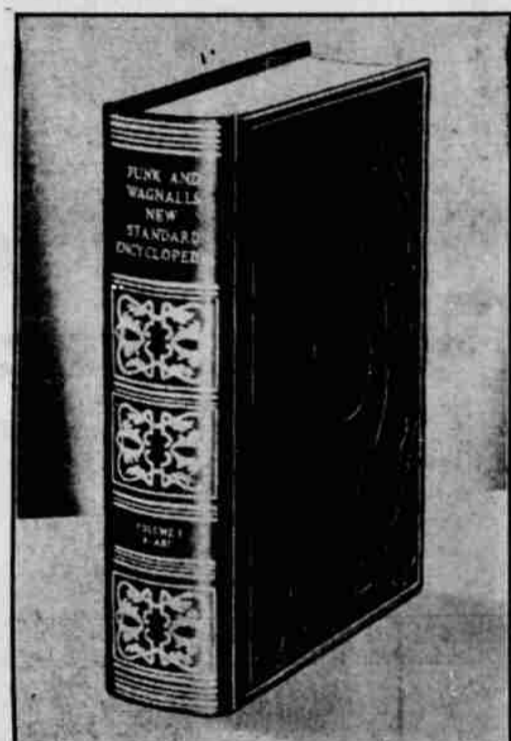
