**French vs. U. S. Wines**

HOLLYWOOD. (AP) — There is room for both French and California wines on America's dinner tables, says Ernest Des Baillets, a vintage connoisseur. France has yet to be surpassed in making "really

fine" wines, but it can't compete with lower cost wines produced in the U. S.

Des Baillets expressed these views after returning from a 23-day tour of such French vineyard areas as Anjou, Touraine, Bordeaux, Cotes-du-Rhone, Alsace, Champagne and Cognac. Fine French wines are

tops, he said, because of differences in climate and soil and the more personal supervision of the product. Des Baillets added that contrary to some reports, the Germans did not take the best wines out of France.
