

# Hoffman Charges Russ Planning to Conquer U.S. 'in Due Course'

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 22 (AP)—Paul G. Hoffman said today that the Russian politburo is "planning to take over this country of ours in due course."

But communism's threat can be wiped out, America's foreign aid chief said, if the United States remains strong and prosperous and Western Europe achieves economic recovery.

In a speech prepared for delivery before the student body of Pomona college, the chief of the economic cooperation administration (ECA) traced the background of events leading to establishment of ECA and the Marshall Plan.

Hoffman lashed out sharply throughout the address at Russian ideological aims. He declared that while American foreign aid can help stem communism, Western Europe must also work to provide economic and political self-help in which freedom can survive.

At the end of World War II, Hoffman recalled, "the leaders of this country saw only too clearly that our freedom, our own way of life was definitely threatened by loss of our historic allies to communism."

Success of the Marshall recovery plan so far, he went on, has turned the tide against the Russians. He continued: "It may be difficult for you to wrap your minds around the fact that the politburo is planning to take over this country of ours in due course. But their purpose is nothing less than this."

Hoffman said the time table of communism called first for the conquest of Western Europe, then Asia, Africa, South America, and finally North America. He commented: "If we in the United States remain strong and prosperous, and above all, if the free people remain united, the evil plans of the men of the Kremlin will fail."
