New Minister In Christian Pulpit Sunday

New pastor of the First Christian church beginning Sunday will be the Rev. George Alder who has accepted the pulpit here in Klamath Falls.

The Rev. Alder comes to the First Christian church from Elmira where he has been the pastor for the past five years.

Other churches the Rev. Alder served were in Liberty and Irvine, Ore., and Ellensburg, Wash. He also formerly served in the department of foreign languages at the University of Oregon as research assistant in classical languages for two years, and one year teaching Greek.

The Rev. and Mrs. Alder and their two daughters, Barbara, 4, and Carolyn, 2, will be at home in the parsonage, 60 Nevada.

At present, the Rev. Alder is president of the Lane County convention of the Churches of Christ. He is a graduate of the University of Oregon and of Northwest Christian College, at Eugene.

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The Bible Story BALAAM

EDITOR'S NOTE: This is the eighth of a series of studies from the Old Testament. The text is condensed from selections by Houston Harbo for the new book, "The Old Testament" illustrated by Guy Rowe, also from the book.

And the children of Israel pitched in the plains of Moab. And Balaam king of the Moabites sent messengers unto Balaam to call him, saying, Behold, there is a people come out from Egypt: they cover the face of the earth, and abide over against me: Come now therefore, curse me this people; that I may drive them out of the land: for I wot that he whom thou blessest is blessed, and he whom thou cursest is cursed.

And Balaam said unto them, Lodge here this night, and I will bring you word again, as the Lord shall speak unto me. And God came unto Balaam and said, Thou shalt not go, thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed. And Balaam rose in the morning, and said unto the princes of Balak, the Lord refused to give me leave to go with you. And they went unto Balak.

And Balak sent yet again princes, more and more honorable. And they came to Balaam, and said, Thus saith Balak, I will promote thee unto very great honour, and I will do whatsoever thou sayest, come, I pray thee, curse me this people. And Balaam said unto the servants of Balak: Tarry ye also here this night, that I may know what the Lord will say. And God came unto Balaam, and said, go with them; but yet the word which I shall say unto thee, do. And Balaam rose in the morning, and went with the princes of Moab. And when Balak heard that Balaam was come he went out to meet him. And Balaam said unto Balak, Lo, I am come unto thee; have I now any power at all to say any thing: the word that God putteth in my mouth, that shall I speak.

And Balak would give him his house full of silver and gold. I cannot go beyond the commandment of the Lord. And now, behold, I go unto my people: come therefore, and I will advertise thee what this people shall do to thy people in the latter days. And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said: I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth.

I speak... And on the morrow Balak took Balaam up into the high places of Baal, that he might see the utmost part of the people.

And Balaam said unto Balak, Build me here seven altars. And Balak and Balaam offered on every altar a bullock and a ram. And Balaam went to an high place. And God met Balaam and said, Return unto Balak and thus thou shalt speak. And he returned unto him, and took up his parable, and said, The king of Moab hath brought me from the mountains of the east, saying, Come, curse me Jacob, and come, defy Israel. How shall I curse whom God hath not cursed? or how shall I defy whom the Lord hath not defied? Lo, the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned among the nations. Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his!

And Balak said, What hast thou done? I took thee to curse mine enemies, and behold, thou hast blessed them. And he answered, Must I not speak that which the Lord hath put in my mouth?

And Balak said, Come unto another place from whence thou shalt not see them all; peradventure it will please God that thou mayest curse me them from thence. And Balak brought Balaam to the top of Peor.

And Balaam lifted up his eyes, and saw Israel abiding in his tents; and the spirit of God came upon him, and he said, How goodly are thy tents, O Israel, thy tabernacles. O Jacob, God brought him forth out of Egypt; he hath as it were the strength of an unicorn: he shall eat up his enemies, and pierce them through with his arrows. Blessed is he that blesseth thee, and cursed is he that curseth thee.

And Balak's anger was kindled, and he said unto Balaam, I called thee to curse mine enemies, and behold, thou hast altogether blessed them. Therefore now flee unto thy place: I thought to promote thee unto great honour; but, lo, the Lord hath kept thee back from honour. And Balaam said unto Balak, If

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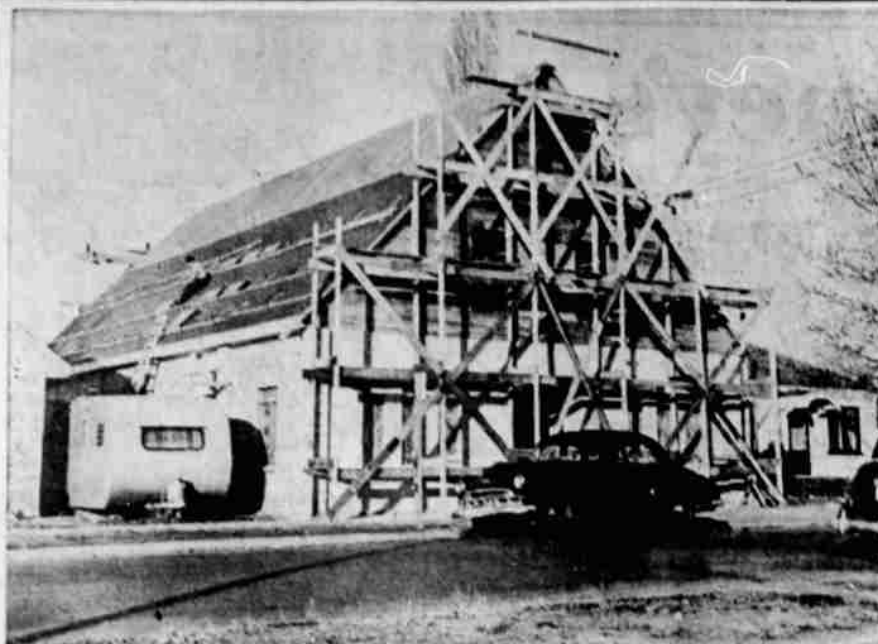
