Desperados Taken After Thrill Chase

MIAMI, Fla., Nov. 25 (AP)—Two desperados who were captured in a movie type chase over roof tops in downtown Miami while fire department searchlights glared over the scene have admitted at least 14 robberies in the Miami area.

Detective Lieut. C. O. Hutto identified the men as George Johnson, 23, and his ex-convict brother-in-law William James McCormack, 31. The pair was cornered by two Miami patrolmen and captured after a hand to hand battle.

Discovered

Hutto said passersby heard strange sounds coming from a hardware store about 2:30 a. m. Five patrol cars, two detective cars and two fire trucks rushed to the scene as two shadowy figures scrambled over the roof tops.

Dozens of shots were fired as the fleeing pair dodged behind cornices and roof top buildings, but on one was struck.

Fire Damage To Famed Church Slight

JERUSALEM, Nov. 25 (AP)—A fire in the Christian-vested Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem's Old City died down today after causing little damage.

The reassuring report was brought by foreign diplomats who visited the fire scene. They said on their return through Arab lines that the blaze only partly damaged the leaden main dome and cupola, and a layer of felt and tar underneath the dome.

The flames, they added, did not damage the reinforced concrete inner layer of the dome or heavy scaffolding inside the church supporting the rotunda itself.

Many Christians believe the church covers the spot where the sepulchre was located. The body of Christ was taken to the sepulchre after the crucifixion. Some authorities, however, question the authenticity of the site.

The fire broke out Wednesday night. Handicapped by lack of modern fire-fighting equipment, Arabs, Moslems and Christians joined in battling the flames. Monks of five denominations moved all the treasures of the shrine to safety. They included sacred images and rich fixtures.

Fremont Fires Bad This Year

LAKEVIEW—The 1949 fire season on the Fremont national forest was the most severe since 1908. It was announced by Supervisor Merle S. Lowden. A total of 156 fires occurred on the forest, burning a total of 841 acres within the protective boundary. Prior to 1949, the largest number of fires in any one year was 104 in 1946. During the five years just past, the average number of fires was 83.

The lightning caused 102 fires this year, breaking the previous record of 80 lightning fires in 1937. Lightning storms started in May and continued throughout the summer, increasing in severity until early September when 48 lightning fires were started between September 1 and 10.

Man-Caused

There were 54 man-caused fires this year, breaking the previous record of 47 in 1934. Twenty-one on these occurred from April to September 30, and 33 of them occurred during the hunting season in October and one in November.
