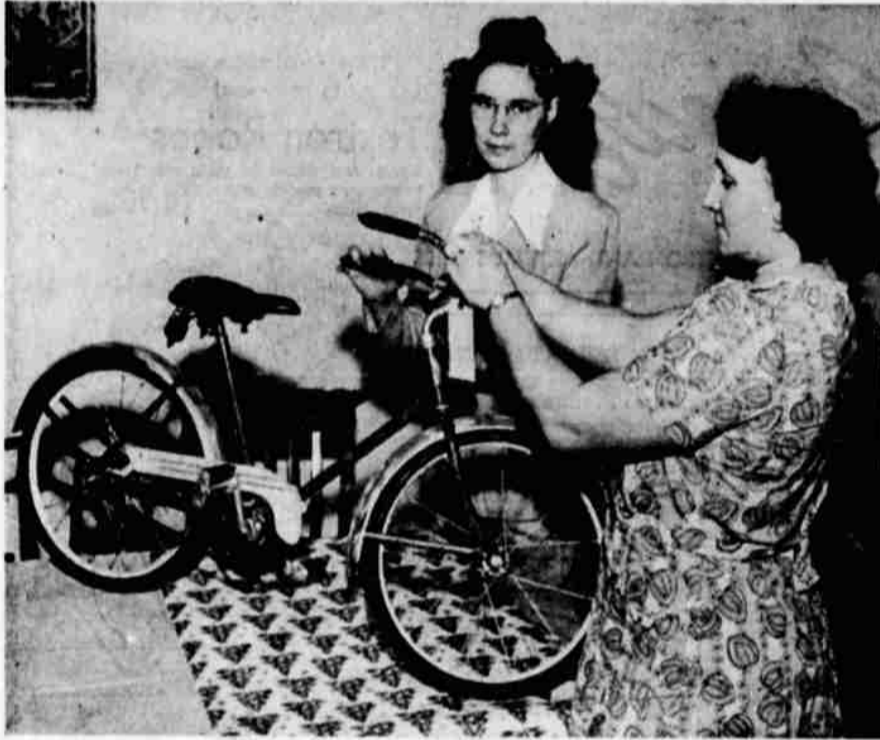

Salvation Army Brings Cheer

Christmas cheer is one of the Salvation Army's most picturesque activities in the community and will include such deeds as Christmas checks for food to deserving families, toy distribution, maintenance of the annual Christmas kettles on the local streets, and Christmas parties for children.

The Salvation Army collects and repairs toys for Christmas distribution. Between 500 and 600 gifts of toys, clothing, and other treats of holiday cheer will be given out at the children's parties and other places, this year alone.

This year's plans include a singing choir from the high school to accompany the army members on their holiday rounds.

Money collected in the Christmas kettles will be used this year for the checks given out to deserving families. The checks will vary in

size from \$10 to \$15 depending on the size of the family and the extent of their needs.

At Christmas time last year the organization assisted 335 individuals

and sent out 69 grocery baskets and orders and befriended more than 500

children and other men and women. The Salvation Army is under the command of Capt. and Mrs. A. Longden.
