**SALES EASE GRAINS DOWN**

CHICAGO, Dec. 8 (AP)—Moderate selling pressure sent grains down a bit without causing any serious losses on the board of trade today. Wheat was about the weakest cereal throughout the session.

Small scale hedging pressure served as a depressing influence in wheat. More cash wheat has come to market recently, particularly at Gulf of Mexico ports.

Wheat closed 1/2-1/4 lower, December \$2.19, corn was 1/4-1/2 lower, December \$1.27 1/2-1.28, oats were 1/4-1/2 lower, December 75 1/2, rye was 1 to 2 cents lower, December \$1.42, soybeans were 1 1/2 to 3 cents lower, and lard was unchanged to 3 cents lower, December \$10.12.

**AMA Votes \$25 Dues For Doctors**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 8 (AP)—The American Medical Association today voted \$25-a-year compulsory dues for its members.

The fund from the dues will finance the AMA's campaign against "socialized medicine" as well as provide financing for other AMA activities.

Dr. George Lull, general manager of the AMA, told reporters the assessment would probably apply to about 85 per cent of the organization's total membership of 142,000.

On that basis, it would provide annual funds of about \$3,000,000.

Lull said several physicians and honorary and associate members of AMA's state medical societies probably would be exempt. Exemptions will be determined by the state societies themselves.

Officials said the AMA had never before had compulsory dues although its constitution permits them.
