day of gain in the distant reservoirs, which have had small but steady increases now for nearly a week.

At last count, the water level stood at 58,410,000 gallons, compared to 58,250,000 the day before. This is small gain of 160,000-000 gallons. The reservoirs are now holding only 34.9 per cent of capacity.

New York homes and apartments use 35 per cent of the water, industry uses 28 per cent, and the rest goes to institutions such as hospitals and the fire department.

On the basis of home consumption, each New Yorker is using about 70 gallons a day. In rough terms, this would fill about one and a half oil drums, or a couple of full bath tubs.

Yesterday's holiday — billed as "showering and bathing" — even reached out and touched the United Nations, which has its headquarters at nearby Lake Success.

In spite of the shaving ban, United Nations Secretary General Trygve Lie showed up with a pink chin—like four out of five New Yorkers.

He apologetically explained about having an electric shaver and then brightened:

"But I had no bath."

Drift Fence To Be Built

TULELAKE—Seven and a half miles of range drift fences are being built in the Doublehead district of the Modoc National forest, 30 miles southeast of here, it was announced today by George Fischer, district ranger.

Fischer has four men, all forestry employees, on the job.

head, according to Ray Linaree of the Eastern Shasta County Flying Posse.

Linaree was flying a Piper cruiser with Eugene McKing, commander of the posse, as observer.

He said the plane was "pretty well scattered" and both bodies were in the wreckage. It is about 1 1/2 miles to the nearest road, and it would take the ground crew several hours to bring out the bodies of the young students.

Three planes took off from Fall River Mills airport to make the search this morning and at least 50 men had gone out on foot.

The little town of Fall River Mills with a population of 600, was "up all night" after word of the crash came in late yesterday afternoon.

The plane did not burn, Linaree said.

Abdullah Sticks To City Powers

AMMAN, Hashemite Jordan, Dec. 17 (AP) — King Abdullah, in a news conference in the part of Jerusalem he holds, said today the U. N. resolution internationalizing that city will not work.

He said most of the city is in Arab hands and "will remain so, with God's will."

"The UN doesn't seem to know the reality of the situation," he declared and added that "neither do the Arab and eastern states."

"We oppose the resolution because it is impracticable," he said.

Abdullah said the Arab respects the holy places of all religions.

Strike Ends At London Station

LONDON, Dec. 17 (AP)—Workers at London's Littlebrook power station marched to their posts this morning, ending an unofficial strike that had threatened London's power supplies for five days.

In two other plants workers went back last night and generators were normal by dawn. At a fourth station, where the men walked out Tuesday because the government moved troops into the struck plants, the men had resumed work on Thursday.

The men had left work first over a pay dispute, then refused to return after a settlement when signs were posted calling their return to work "unconditional."

700 Jews Leave For Israel Homes

WARSAW, Dec. 17 (AP) — The largest group of Jews yet to leave Poland for Israel — 700 men, women and children — departed yesterday in a special train for Bari, Italy, their first stop en route.

The refugees ranged in age from infants — in arms to grandfathers. Polish authorities allowed them to take a limited quantity of personal belongings.

It was reported in Jewish circles the group was required to pay their fares in dollars, since emigrants are considered no longer Poles. Financial regulations require non-Poles to pay fares in hard currency.

The trip to Israel was organized jointly by the International Red Cross and the Polish Red Cross.
