

Pastors Plan Evangelistic Drive for Military Camps

NEW YORK, (AP)—A battalion of preachers plans to visit the nation's military camps.

It will be the biggest drive to carry the gospel to the armed forces since World War two.

"The armed forces are ripe for a revival," said Maj. Gen. Roy H. Parker, chief of chaplains of the army.

Week-long preaching missions, beginning early next January and lasting through February, are scheduled for 80 army camps and 30 naval bases.

PLANNED Plans for the evangelistic drive were mapped by the general commission of chaplains, of Washington, and the National Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA.

Dr. Stewart M. Robinson, Elizabeth, N. J., spokesman for a sponsors committee, called it the first nationwide evangelistic campaign organized for service personnel and their families.

It has the backing of about 40 Protestant and Orthodox denominations.

Approximately 250 civilian clergymen, operating in three-man teams, will fan out to the various military posts.

Each preaching mission will open on a Sunday and continue through the following Friday night.

URGENT Both the chaplains and civilian clergy are convinced that such an effort is urgent, Robinson said, adding:

"The spiritual experience of the men and women in the armed forces will determine the spiritual atmosphere in years to come."

VETS' EDUCATION

PORTLAND, (AP)—Two Korean war veterans will attend college next year under provisions of a state postwar education benefit bill. U.S. May Hit Gambling Along Famed 'Gold Coast'

BILOXI, Miss., (AP)—Reports cropped up today the federal government planned to throw its weight behind an anti-gambling drive along Mississippi's famed "Gold Coast."

Within the past few days federal agents have been here investigating gambling activities with particular reference to participation by service men.

The reports gained added significance with a statement by Sen. Kefauver (D-Tenn.) that "a bad gambling situation exists" in Biloxi with Keesler air force base servicemen being "fleece."

Kefauver said at Washington the senate preparedness subcommittee is "on top of the situation."

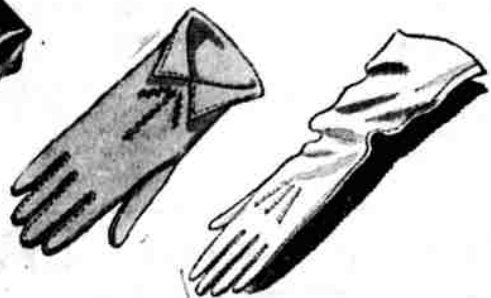
