House OKs More School Aid

WASHINGTON, (AP) — The House of Representatives passed Monday and sent to the Senate a bill to provide increased federal aid to schools in critical defense areas. The House vote was 257 to 83.

Local communities now may obtain federal aid if they can show a big boost in school population because of defense program activity. The bill would permit them to obtain help beforehand in anticipation of such an increase.
