### Father Kills Son in Game

CLEVELAND (AP)—A young father playing cowboys with his two-year-old son killed the boy Monday night with a borrowed pistol which he believed was unloaded. The victim was Dale Perry, only child of Mr. and Mrs. Dominic Perry, 23, in the side. The bullet from the .42 calibre automatic ripped through the boy's chest and slightly wounded Mrs. Perry, 23, in the side. Perry, a 28-year-old truck driver, told police he played cowboys with the boy after they watched a Western film on television. The boy kept pointing a toy pistol at his father and so Perry grabbed a pistol he had borrowed from his brother and took out the clip forgetting to check for a bullet in the chamber, he pulled the trigger. ### Reds Order Two to Death

WARSAW, Poland, (AP)—Two men were condemned to death and nine others, including four Roman Catholic priests, were sentenced to prison yesterday on conviction of joining in underground activities against the Communist government. Marian Pilarski and Stanislaw Bizio were judged chief organizers of underground activities, including several political murders, in the Lublin district between 1944 and 1950. They were sentenced to die after a seven-day trial in the Lublin regional military court. Father Andrzej Szepejak, a member of the Saint Bernard order of Poland, was sentenced to 15 years in prison on charges he encouraged use of Radecania monastery as an arsenal and hideout for the underground group. He denies the accusation.

### Gang Breaks Dock Strike

NEW YORK (AP)—Striking longshoremen returned to work today at Brooklyn's huge army base, after underworld figure Anthony Anastasia led an imported crew of workers through the gates. The back-to-work move at the army base, one of the nation's major shipping centers for Korea and other military outposts, came as the government considered bringing in troops to handle cargoes. Anastasia, accused before the senate crime committee of leading hired "goons and thugs" to break another strike, showed up at the base this morning with several truckloads of men.

As the men followed him through the gates, some 250 striking stevedores outside began killing about restlessly. One of them climbed atop a car, and yelled at the others.

They also were shouting about "a gang of criminals taking our jobs." Speakers denounced Joseph Ryan, head of the AFL International Longshoremen's Assoc. who had blamed the walkout on Communists. "There, in a body, the stevedores streamed onto the piers. As they shaped up for work, Anastasia and his followers beat a hasty retreat. Although cargoes were moving again at the army base, the wildcat strike still continued at other piers scattered along the miles of Brooklyn harbor front and along the Hudson river in Manhattan N.Y.M.

Anastasia, brother of the notorious Albert, the reputed one-time triggerman of Murder, Inc. refused to say who had employed him to bring in the outside workers. Anastasia was accused before the crime committee last March of having been paid \$1000 a day to lead a gang to break up a strike against the Phelps Dodge Co., of Elizabeth, N.J. in 1946. He denied it.

### Tax Probe Recessed

WASHINGTON, (AP)—House members investigating the affairs of the internal revenue bureau called a one-day recess today before returning tomorrow to the finances of the former Boston collector, Denis W. Delaney.

Delaney was fired from his post this year, and is under indictment in Boston on bribery counts. Committee counsel Adrian W. Dewind told newsmen Delaney's attorney had turned down an invitation for the former collector to appear. Tomorrow, the committee has scheduled Daniel Friedman, a partner in a New York insurance company, the estate research bureau. Friedman was named yesterday by Maxwell Shapiro and Louis Hellmann, Boston businessmen, as a "tax expert" who promised to take care of their tax troubles and who, they said, was personally endorsed by Delaney.
