AUGUSTA, Ga., (P) — After deliberating less than three hours, a Richmond county jury acquitted Mrs. Margie Kennedy late yesterday of the murder of her husband, former Augusta police commissioner and political leader John B. Kennedy.

At the three-day trial, the frail, 43-year-old woman read an unsworn statement, permitted under Georgia law, saying that Kennedy had subjected her to constant physical brutality for nearly 20 years. She claimed she shot him in self-defense and did not intend to kill him.

Kennedy, who once headed the powerful Cracker party in Augusta, was shot six times at his home June 30. Two doctors, called by the state, told the court that in their opinion his death was not caused primarily by the bullets.

# Farmer Hits OTI Expense

PORTLAND, (P) — The state should learn to economize rather than look for new sources of income, speakers told the Portland League of Women Voters here yesterday.

"We must cut expenses to fit our income, not expand our income to fit expenses," Giles French, state legislator and Sherman county editor, said.

He urged especially cuts in school and welfare programs.

Howard Morgan, Monmouth farmer and former legislator, opposed any cuts in welfare or school programs, but advocated other economies.

He was critical of the cost of operating Oregon Technical Institute at Klamath Falls and what he said was the secretary of state's practice of spending \$100,000 annually for a press clipping service.

Morgan also opposed a sales tax and suggested that any further taxes be raised through income taxes.
