

# Young French Dancer Says U.S. Men Best Husbands

HOLLYWOOD, (AP)—Leslie Caron, the young French dancing sensation, got herself a Hollywood career and an American husband in less than a year, and she's wild about both.

Miss Caron, a mite of a lass with a puckish face, is conscientious about her dancing and taken between two and three hours of lessons daily. I interrupted her pirouettes long enough to learn her

feelings about American men and one in particular. He is her recent husband, George Hornel, young heir to the meat packing fortune.

"Why did you marry an American?" I inquired.

"The men in France have become very cynical since the war. I suppose that is only natural, since they went through so much. But it makes it difficult for the women.

"I have a brother who is typical of the male thinking. I used to hear him discussing girls with his friends. 'Girls!' he would say. 'They are all stupid!' Now I can hardly wait for some girl to make him fall madly in love. He will change his tune."

American men, she added, are much more considerate of their women. "They place women on a pedestal," she said, indicating that the girls like to be there.

"But the French take marriage more seriously," Miss Caron continued. "When a French man proposes marriage to a girl, it is for life. There is never a thought of divorce, no matter how unhappy the marriage turns out to be.

"In America, it is different. The young couples go into marriage too lightly. They figure if it doesn't work out, they can always get a divorce and try someone else."

Miss Caron, who makes her film debut with Gene Kelly in "An American in Paris," said she and her husband agreed that her career would continue after marriage. But she takes a French attitude about what would happen if her film work should interfere with their domestic life. "I believe I would retire," she said.

Even though he can neither read nor write music, he can play just about every instrument and is thinking about a musical career. Meanwhile, he is in the coast guard reserve and undergoes training once weekly in San Francisco.

Like all newlyweds, the pair went through the chore of meeting each other's families. Of George's father Leslie said: "He is a businessman, but he is very kind with people." They visited the Hornel estate at Austin, Minn., and then saw her parents in the Virgin Islands.

"Marriage," she glowed, as she returned to her arabesques, "it is wonderful."
