ACTRESS DIES

SOUTH NORWALK, Conn.,—Actress Mandy Christians, best known for her portrayal of mama in the Broadway hit, "I Remember Mama," died Sunday night. Death came three hours after she was admitted to Norwalk hospital following a cerebral hemorrhage suffered at New Canaan, Conn., where she had been staying recently.

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
