Removing Marks From Windows

In the good old days—say about 100 B. C.—Halloween meant lighting bonfires and keeping out of the way of ghosts and witches. It was a fearsome time.

Today the celebrating is, on the whole, more cheerful, at least for the younger generation. But many a parent probably has wished, more than once, to be rid of the youngsters' pranks and have the ghosts and witches back. The scariest spook is preferable to a soap scrawl on the car—and easier to remove. That's why we have today some pertinent pointers from the petroleum industry on how to remedy this sort of damage. Oil, you see, is the source of several materials that can prove useful in eradicating

crayon, candle or soap markings on your auto or house windows. (We won't mention that it is also the source of materials in the suitably named "ghost" and "spook" crayons, candles and soaps.) Wax crayon or candle markings call for application of gasoline, kerosene, turpentine or mineral spirits, and then a soap and water cleaning. If you were the really forward-thinking type, and suspected that some little imps planned to use chalk on your windows, you wiped the windows in advance with vaseline or lubricating oil on a soft cloth.

There are two effective things you can do about soap scrawls on your car. Because some soaps may injure or change the color of the paint, they should be removed with hot water before they dry and harden if you discover the spook tracks soon enough. Treat with glycerine and then wash them off if you don't discover them right away.

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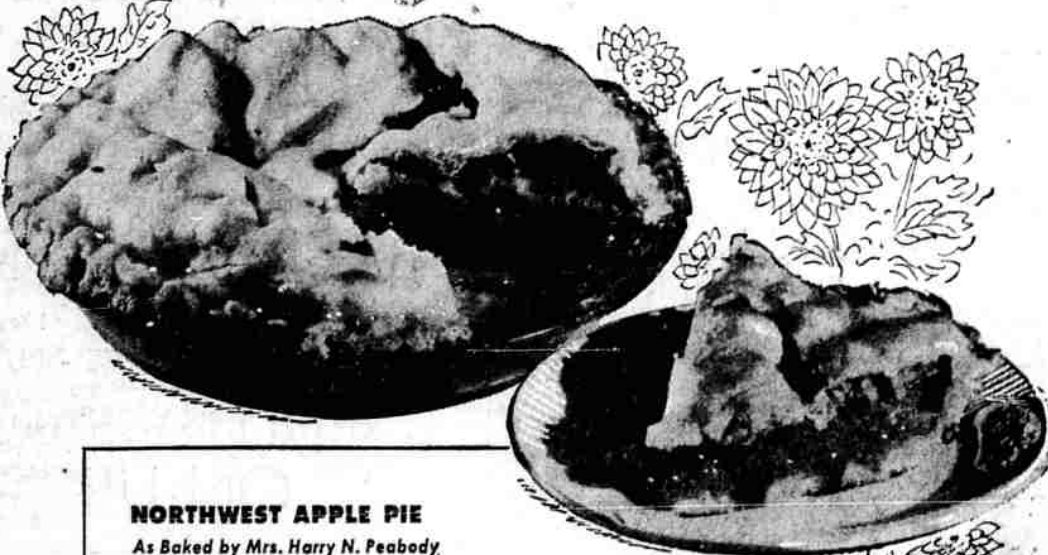

NORTHWEST APPLE PIE

As Baked by Mrs. Harry N. Peabody

½ cup shortening
2 cups sifted Crown Unbleached Flour
1 teaspoon salt

Rub and pinch with fingers until flour is absorbed. Add about 5 tablespoons cold water and work until a ball is formed. Roll out half of dough into a circle large enough to fit loosely in pie pan. Roll other half for top, place in refrigerator. Mix together ¼ cup sugar and 1 table-

spoon flour, sprinkle on bottom crust. Use 5 or 6 sliced apples and arrange in pie shell. Add about 1 cup sugar and 1 table-spoon flour. Season with cinnamon, nutmeg, and chunks of butter. Moisten edge of bottom crust before placing top crust. With cream, brush top of pie, then cut holes for ventilation. Bake at 450 degrees for 10 minutes, then reduce heat to 400 degrees for 40 minutes.
