Plan Sought By Dixiecrats
SHELMA, Ala.—(AP)—Rebellious Dixie Democrats tested the anti-Truman winds here Thursday but failed to come up with any specific plan to keep him from heading the party ticket again.

Even the keynote speaker, Virginia's Sen. Harry Byrd, caustic critic of the Truman administration, had nothing concrete to suggest as to what course the South should take.

Plan Sought By Dixiecrats (continued)
At next year's national convention Southern Democrats should press for return to the two-thirds rule for picking the party nominee, he said, and seek to revise the party platform so it will be more acceptable to the South.

Plan Sought By Dixiecrats (continued)
There was a strong undertone in his address to the Dallas county farm bureau hinting that the Southern states have 128 electoral votes which could go to someone other than the national party nominee.

Plan Sought By Dixiecrats (continued)
Almost nothing was decided in the well advertised "strategy caucus" of states rights partisans led by most of the top brass among Southern Democrats.

Plan Sought By Dixiecrats (continued)
Sentiment of many present was sounded by Gov. Herman Talmadge of Georgia, who gave this explanation of why he skipped the caucus: "I want to see the whites of their eyes before I fire."

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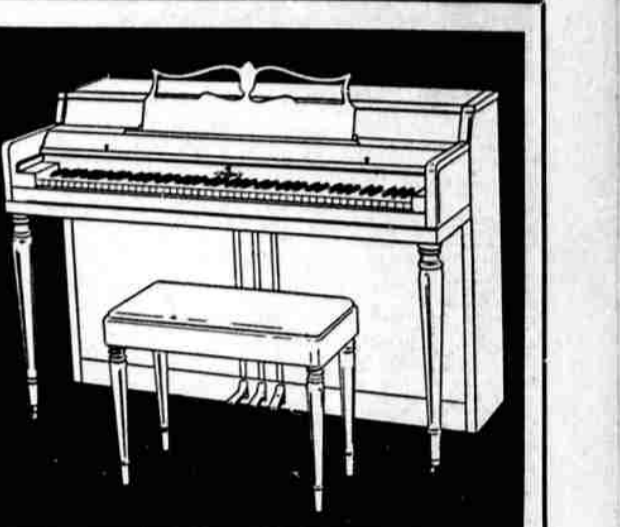
