Bride's 10-Minute Journey To Freedom Takes 3 Years

NEW YORK. (AP)—A 10-minute ferry boat ride separated German bride Ellen Knauff from the country she wants to call home—but it was a three-year voyage of anxiety and tears.

Her way was blocked by charges she was a Czech spy. Her goal was obscured by the mirage of false hope. Her first impulse this morning well might be to ask if it isn't all a dream.

The voyage ended last night, and Mrs. Knauff had her goal of a "permanent residence" in the United States.

She stepped ashore from Ellis Island less than two hours after U.S. Atty. Gen. J. Howard McGrath in Washington announced his approval of her entry.

"First of all," she told newsmen on her arrival in Manhattan, "I want to get in touch with my husband, Kurt."

"Next I want to have a lobster supper."

"Then, if I may, I want to be an American citizen."

Her husband, Kurt W. Knauff, a former American soldier, could not meet her because he is in Hanau, Germany, as a U.S. army civilian employee.

Mrs. Knauff carried a book she wrote while on Ellis Island, a tentative title, she said, is "It's all up to Washington"—for it was in Washington where her main story unfolded.

The narrative had its start August 13, 1948, when she arrived here as a new bride to take up residence for U.S. citizenship.

She was taken to Ellis Island in New York harbor and not told why admission was denied. Aliens whose entry status is questionable are detained on the island.

Not until March, 1950, did the board of immigration appeals give her a hearing. Two months later she was ordered deported as a "security risk."

An appeal delayed action on the order, and Rep. Francis E. Walter (D-Pa.) successfully put a bill through the house of representatives granting her entry. But the senate did not act.

Twice she failed in pleas to the U.S. supreme court.

New hope came last January when her husband arrived here on a short vacation. She was freed from Ellis Island in his custody. But the parole was short-lived.

BREAK
In March, she was sent back to the island, her hopes all but dashed. A special immigration board of inquiry ruled her a Czech spy in 1947, when she worked for the U.S. army headquarters in Frankfurt.

Three Czechs who worked for their country's military mission in Frankfurt made the charge. She denied it.

Ordered deported again, Associate Justice Robert H. Jackson issued a stay of execution of the order minutes before she was to have boarded a plane for Germany.

The action allowed her to make a new appeal. Recently the board reversed its earlier decision, and last night McGrath made her victory final.

Legally Dead Man Returns

LOS ANGELES. (AP)—After a life of wanderlust, Charlie Guerionni has learned that he has been listed as legally "dead" for 28 years in the files of a Los Angeles court.

Guerionni settled here in 1919 with his bride, Angelina, but four years later, after the birth of a son, Guerionni left in search of adventure.

In 1923 he returned briefly to handle the custody of the boy, Felice, and then left again. The pair finally became farmers in Italy, but when world war started, Felice returned to America to enlist.

After the war Guerionni lived with his son and daughter-in-law in Pennsylvania, returning here to handle the estate when he heard his wife had died.

Thus, he learned his wife had declared him legally dead so she could mortgage their home here.

EL PASO, TEX. (AP)—Sheppard (Abdullah) King III, with a Mexican quickie divorce in his pocket, made big plans today to wed his beloved belly dancer.

King met his wife, curvaceous Gloria, at a 30-minute session Friday in a civil court at Rio Grande.

Next it's off to the land of the Nile and the arms of Egyptian topos to Sami Gaural for the Sandy-haired Houston oil heir.

Until he leaves in a couple of weeks, he'll stay in El Paso to "brush up on my tequila drinking and the mambo (a dance)," King told a reporter.

Judge Jesus Barbara Cornejo called a special session of his Juarez court on All Saints Day to grant the divorce. The grounds were incompatibility.

King met Samia in Paris and courted her there and in Cairo. After their love blossomed, he embraced the Moslem faith and adopted the name Abdullah.

Then it was discovered he hadn't been divorced from Gloria, whom he married twice.

She tried for an annulment at Houston but Houston Atty. Robert Sonfield intervened to delay the case.

King said he will leave late in November for Cairo and "we'll get married as soon as I get there."

"When I get there, I'm going to drink Egypt in champagne. You won't be able to tell Cairo from the Nile except that the Nile will be filled with water," he added.

Asked about a Moslem ban on drinking, Abdullah said: "Sure, Moslems have rules against it, but I'm what you might call a modern Moslem."
