Malin Faces Phoenix Saturday in Medford

Malin meets Phoenix Saturday, 8 p.m., for the Class B title in Dist. 5 on the Medford high school field.

Jim Conroy's Mustangs wrapped up the Klamath county title Saturday with a 31-6 win over Henry.

Phoenix won the Jackson county title with a 20-13 win over Rogue River October 5.

For both teams it means more than a district title.

TO STATE
The winner goes against the Dist. 6 team—yet undetermined—in a quarterfinal state play-off game.

Conroy said his team came out of the rough Henry game in fine shape and should be at full strength for the Pirates.

Phoenix, coached by Jack Woodward, holds a 6-1 record going into the game. In addition to Rogue River, its only league game, Phoenix has beaten Eagle Point, junior varsity teams of Grants Pass, Medford and Ashland, and Myrtle Creek.

LOST RETURN
The Pirates lost to the Grants Pass jayvees in a return game.

Malin boasts a 6-0 record, five over county league teams and a 62-0 rout of the Klamath Union high school sophomores (Wildcats).

Gavilan Picked Over Janiro

DETROIT (AP)—Kid Gavilan, the welterweight champion with the bolo punch, ranked as a 7 to 5 favorite to defeat middleweight contender Tony Janiro in a 10-round, non-title fight here tonight.

Janiro, who lost a split decision to Gavilan last December in Cleveland, was expected to enter the ring at 153 pounds, about three or four pounds heavier than Gavilan.

Tentative teams now are Hilltop, West-Hilltop, Palmer, Lumber Co., Rickys, Herald and News and Payless Drugs.

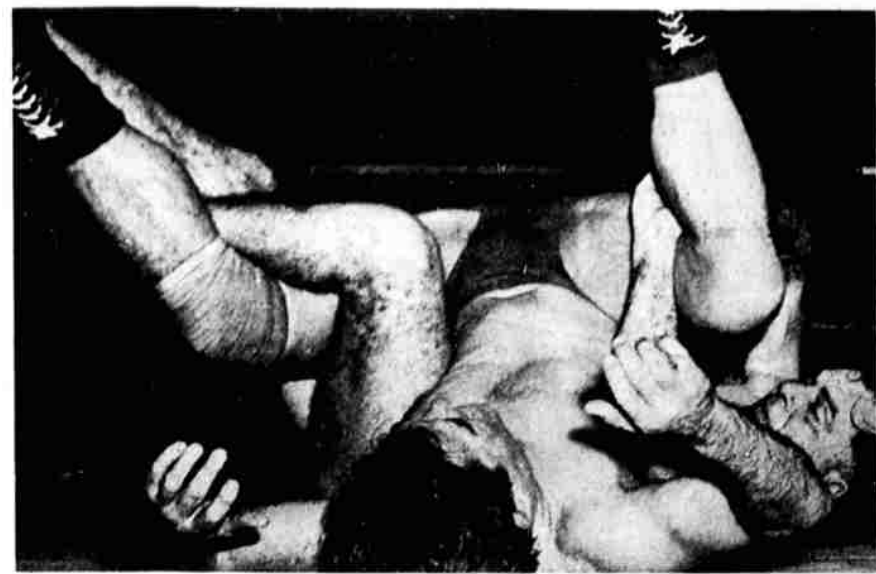
ALTA MONT

Gifford, Cameron Top PCC

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Two half-backs who operate from the tail-back spot of the single wing offense are the leading yard gainers in the Pacific Coast conference.

They are senior Frank Gifford of Southern California, who has gained 658 yards in 136 plays for an average gain of 4.8 per carry, and sophomore Paul Cameron of UCLA, whose total offense lists 1080 yards—412 rushing and 668 passing.

Gifford replaced California's full-back, Johnny Olszewski, who has been sidelined by injuries. Johnny O has gained 588 yards rushing.

Leading passer in the loop is Stanford's Gary Kerkorian, with 67 completions in 107 throws for 902 yards and a 58.9 percent completion record. He has had five interceptions and has thrown five touchdown strikes.

Leading scorer is fullback Hugh McElhenry of Washington, with 76 points.
