Christmas is in the air and Butte Valley unit 478, American Legion auxiliary, is planning a Christmas gift shop for veterans and wives and children of veterans.

Gifts for the shop may be left at the homes of Lillie McIntyre, rehabilitation chairman and Vivian McIntyre, hospital and patients' welfare chairman before November 10.

The following articles are suggested for men: pipes, cartons of cigarettes, lighters, ball point pens, ties, socks, sweaters, T-shirts, shaving materials, belts, wallets and playing cards. For women: costume jewelry, lingerie, hosiery, purses, fancy soaps, scarves and bedroom slippers.

For boys: sweaters, T-shirts, sport shirts, socks, games, toys, books, paint sets, baseballs and bats. Girls: dresses, pinafores, pajamas, slips, panties, mittens, ribbons, dolls, pencil sets and blouses, erasers, rompers, cuddle toys, and plastic playthings.

Mark or leave sizes on wearing apparel. Gifts are to be new but not expensive and are not to be wrapped.

Articles will be displayed and the veteran patient can select gifts for his family and relative for Christmas. The gift is then wrapped for the patient and mailed to his family.
