New Klamath Parson, Wife Hard-Hitting Church Team

The Rev. and Mrs. Gerald Emerson have turned their Christian education talents from South America to Klamath Falls.

Presbyterian Board of Foreign Mission in Colombia, was recently appointed assistant to the Rev.

Emerson and his wife form a smooth-working, efficient team; both were college educated for Christian education work and both have had several years experience in the work.

As assistant pastor at the First Presbyterian, Emerson's chief work is schooling for ages from three through adult.

In the few weeks since the Emersons took over church school attendance has shown a marked increase.

The First Presbyterians recently completed a new educational building, first unit of a proposed new

church. It was believed the new education unit would solve the church's pressing need for Sunday School room. But at a recent congregational meeting, Emerson remarked some of the new rooms were already overcrowded.

The Rev. Emerson and Mrs. Emerson were graduated from Coe (Presbyterian) college and Emerson has since done extensive post-graduate work.

Besides two terms of service in Colombia, Emerson has held pastorates in Great Falls and Stanford, Mont. He was on the verge of accepting another pulpit when he was offered and accepted his appointment here.

In their last Colombian assignment, Emerson supervised the building of Colegio Americano and Mrs. Emerson was the mission school's grade school superintendent.
