The city library offers the following suggestions for juvenile reading . . . for giving.

Mother Goose, beautifully illustrated by Tasha Tude, small enough for a child to handle.

Ring 'O Roses, a book of nursery rhymes illustrated by L. L. Brooke.

For older children—Aesop fables; Alice's Adventures in Wonderland; Carroll; Wonderful adventures of Nils, an idle cruel boy, reduced to elfin size for a malicious mischief who migrates north with the wild geese and learns lessons of love and helpfulness; Lagerlof; Adventures of Pinocchio, capers and adventures of a wooden marionette; Lorenzini; Great Quillow, the toy maker, who saved his town from the plundering of Hunder, the giant; Thurber; Grimm's Fairy Tales; White Ring, a fanciful bit of Celtic legend from Cornwall; Tregarthen; Andersen's Fairy Tales.

Books for children from three to eight years—The Bundle Book, Kraus; Lost In The Zoo, a little boy goes to the zoo with his sister, Hader; Tim and the Tool Chest, Beini; Brownie Bear's Picnic, Wood.

Interest levels from nine to 12 years—Eddie and Gardenia, the story of a pet goat, Haywood; Too Many Turtles, Brock; The Apple and Arrow, the story of William Tell and the Swiss struggle for freedom; Bull, One Little Indian, the adventures of a desert
