

Nobel Prize-Winning Scientist Denied Visa To Visit American Scene

NEW YORK, (U.P.)—Dr. Ernest B. Chain, Nobel prize winner and co-discoverer of penicillin, twice has been denied visas to come to the United States.

Both requests for visas were made at the United States consulate in Rome, the American committee for the Weizmann institute of science said today.

The first application was made last April. It sought permission for the German-born scientist, who is now a British citizen, to come to the United States to undertake a United Nations world health organization mission in the United States, England and the Netherlands.

He was to study antibiotics in installations, visit the American type culture collection in Washington and to consult with scientists here on the possibilities of stimulating research abroad in the development of penicillin, streptomycin and other "wonder" drugs.

When his visa request to the Rome consulate first was rejected, Dr. Chain asked the help of the world health organization, which filed a formal request with the state department. This request dragged on without action and the application was withdrawn. The United Nations agency said that because of the delay it was compelled to make other arrangements.

The second visa request was made by the Weizmann institute's American committee. It asked that the Rome consulate be instructed to issue a visa to permit Dr. Chain to come here for the institute's \$500,000 fund raising dinner last week in honor of the 77th birthday of Dr. Chain Weizmann, president of Israel.

Rejection of this application brought a letter from Dr. Chain, in which he said the action was not explained beyond the statement that it was rejected because of security reasons. The letter, sent to Meyer W. Weissgal, chairman of the Weizmann institute's executive council, reaffirmed Dr. Chain's disinterest in politics or political affiliations.

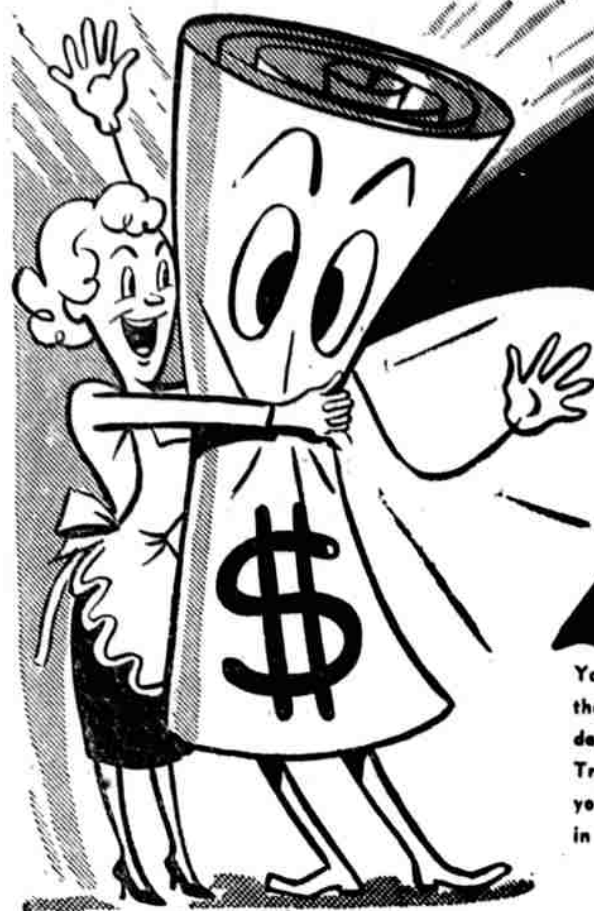
In another letter to Weissgal, Dr. Chain said he was "no more Communist than Acheson." He said the visa might have been denied because of a mission he made to Czechoslovakia on behalf of the world health organization to restore a penicillin plant in that country.

Freak Tornado Rips New Orleans

NEW ORLEANS, (U.P.)—A freakish tornado ripped through the uptown industrial section here early Wednesday and caused damages estimated at more than \$1,000,000, but no one was reported injured.

Tornadoes are extremely rare in this area often frequented by hurricanes. George L. Canady of the U.S. weather bureau, who made the damage estimate, said the tornado was about 400 to 600 feet wide and about 1200 feet long.

The tornado lasted about five minutes between 2:37 a.m. (CST) and 2:52 a.m. The weather bureau was unable to clock the winds in the path of the tornado, but Canady said it was not uncommon for winds of 200 to 300 miles an hour to accompany one.
