Schools May Get Master Program

PORTLAND, Ore.—At an informal meeting Monday the state board of higher education voted to permit three state education colleges to award master degrees in elementary teacher training.

Harry K. Newburn, president of the University of Oregon—the only school in the state with the master education program—opposed the plan.

Presidents of the state's three education colleges—Dr. Robert J. Mancke, Oregon College of Education, Menmouth; Dr. Elmo N. Stevenson, Southern Oregon College, Ashland; and Dr. Roderick G. Langston, Eastern Oregon College, La Grande—requested the program.

Final board action will be taken.

LA CANADA, Calif., (UP)—Eight-year old Jimmy Jones didn't stub his first big case. He got his man.

Sheriff's officers credit Jimmy for the apprehension of James Monroe Russell, 34, of Placerville, Calif., gravely wounded Monday while fleeing from an attempted holdup.

Capt. Vic England of the Monterey sheriff's sub-station said that if it hadn't been for Jimmy's quick thinking, Russell would have gotten away. England says Russell is suspected of being the "green scarf bandit" in other holdups in Reno, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Sacramento and other cities.

He says Russell wore a green scarf over part of his face yesterday when he went to the home of Jimmy Jones' parents, Mr. and Mrs. B. G. Jones, and forced them to drive him to the super-market which Jones manages.

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Wheat Shipments Set New Record

PORTLAND, Ore.—Wheat exports from Columbia river ports so far this year are nearly twice as large as the previous record year.

The merchants exchange reported yesterday that 61,000,000 bushels have been shipped from the ports. This compares with the previous high of 31,000,000 bushels shipped in 1927. Both totals include Portland shipments.

From downriver ports, 13,685,850 bushels went to India and 13,278,418 to Japan this year. Some 16,894,423 bushels went to Japan and 10,534,249 to India from Portland.
