Joe Kahut Next For Ex-Champ

By RUSS NEWLAND SAN FRANCISCO, (AP)—Former heavyweight champion Ezzard Charles has finally convinced light heavyweight title holder Joey Maxim, after five beatings, that it is a hopeless cause to challenge him.

Charles, who confidently expects to punch the crown off Jersey Joe Walcott's head in their return fight early next year, dashed Maxim's hopes for a successful foray into the heavier division at the Cow Palace last night.

The lean Cincinnati Negro out-punched the 175 pound king to win an unanimous 12 round decision handily.

Troy Gets Spotlight In PCC Gripe Confab

CARMEL, Calif. (AP)—Pacific Coast conference football coaches held an extraordinary gripe session yesterday, and though no direct accusations were made, the University of Southern California got the spotlight.

Coach Howie Odell of Washington brought a condensed film version of the USC-Washington game at the request of Huskie faculty representative, Prof. H. P. Everest.

"Odell did not introduce the subject of rough play," Everest said, "but when it came up, we showed the pictures."

Six new rules, obviously aimed at the de-emphasis of football, were adopted:

- 1. A fifth official, the back judge, will be used next fall to detect infractions after the play has gone beyond the line of scrimmage. He will watch the side line for hook passes, and relieve the field judge of the duty of coming up on plays.
