CHOCOLATE BRAZIL NUT FUDGE
 2 cups sugar
 2-3 cup of milk
 2 squares unsweetened chocolate
 2 T. light corn syrup
 2 T. butter or margarine
 1/2 teas. vanilla

SALTED BRAZIL NUT CHIPS
 1 1/2 cups shelled Brazil nuts
 2 Tbs. butter or margarine
 1 teas. salt
 Cover nuts with cold water. Bring slowly to a boil. Simmer 2 to 3

minutes. Drain and cut into thin lengthwise slices with sharp knife. Spread out on shallow pan. Dot with butter. Sprinkle with salt. Bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees) 15 to 20 minutes, stirring occasionally. Yield - approximately 2 cups Brazil nut chips.
