Student Newspaper Gives College \$400,000 Building

LEXINGTON, Ky.—A student-operated weekly newspaper has given the University of Kentucky a gift valued at \$400,000.

But to the many students and advisors who have put the Kentucky Kernel to press for over 5 years, it is a dream come true which far exceeds the monetary value involved.

Half of the buildings' construction cost has been paid from accumulated profits of the student-operated newspaper. Revenue bonds covering the remainder of the cost are to be retired from future earnings of the paper.
