Texas Stands Off Louisiana's Plan Of Crane Grabbing

CORPUS CHRISTI, Tex., (AP)—The Gulf coast is all worked up about birds again. This time Texas is delaying Louisiana to separate those whooping lovebirds, Jo and Crip. Louisiana wants back a whooping crane it loaned Texas. Texas says Louisiana can't have her—of him. The states can't even agree on the sex. Besides, point out Texas fowl fanciers, their feathers still ruffled over the great pelican question, the Louisiana whooping crane is a mate of the Texas bird and it would be breaking up a family to separate them. Also, Jo and Crip might produce a baby whooper. That would bring joy to naturalists. For there are only 8 whooping cranes known to exist and naturalists fear the birds will become extinct unless some little whoopers come along. Only a few weeks ago, the two states were battling over pelicans. Texas got the jump on Louisiana by replenishing the pelican supply in St. James park near Buckingham Palace in England. That's what Louisiana deeply. It wanted to supply the pelicans. The odd appearing fowls are Louisiana's state bird. A few months before that, the states were at each other's throats over shrimp. Texas tried to tax Louisiana shrimp boat operators so heavily they couldn't afford to operate off Texas' shore. Federal courts settled that one in Louisiana's favor. Jo, the female crane, or Crip, the male, was borrowed from New Orleans' Audubon park zoo as a mate for the bird at the U.S. wildlife refuge in Austin, Tex. They have been mates five years and produced one offspring. The young crane was lost, probably to a predatory animal. The Audubon zoo's superintendent, George Douglass, said he plans to come to Texas, claim his bird—and he says it's Crip, the male—and return with it to Louisiana Saturday. Immediately, Naturalist Julian Howard, Austin well refuge manager, said Douglass couldn't get Jo or Crip without a fight. He said he would ask his boss in the U.S. wildlife service in Washington, "what the score is." Howard says the New Orleans zoo's bird is Jo, the female. And, he says, he has no idea of giving up Crip, even if Douglass should get Jo. This statement was brought forth by a remark by Douglass that he could breed whoopers in captivity. So far as he knows, Howard said, the zoo has no male of its own. It would have to take a male, probably Crip, from the refuge to carry out the captivity breeding plan. The whoopers, which once blotted out the sun as they flew in great flocks, now are reduced to 8. Each fall they fly to the Texas refuge. When spring comes, they seek to the far north, where no one ever has found their summer home. Only Jo and Crip stay here. They are crippled and can't fly.
