

### Rough Time For Pilot

BATTLE CREEK, N.J. — Frost-bitten Lloyd Bowen classified the 10 minutes he spent on the tail of a spinning small plane yesterday as his most harrowing experience—and he was a gunner on a B-29 superfort in world war two. Here's what happened:

Bowen, 39, landed his two-place single engine Cessna at Kellogg airport and started taxiing toward a hangar. The engine coughed out in the seven above zero cold. Bowen alighted to spin the propeller by hand and get the engine started again.

It started with a roar and almost stopped Bowen down. He wrapped his arms around the rudder as it passed and held on, but the plane didn't stop. He forced the rudder to the side, making the plane run in a circle.

Finally, after ten freezing, dizzying minutes, the spinning plane was spotted by the airport tower. A crash truck speeded up. Two attendants jumped off and grabbed the tail with Bowen, who then let loose and ran to the cockpit forcing in the throttle he'd left too far out in the first place.

Caked with snow and ice when he got off, Bowen got first aid for his frostbitten face and ears. He also got a bruised leg. Airport authorities said the engine was running around 2000 revolutions per minute during its wild, but Bowen-controlled, spree. At that speed, they said, the plane, without a man's weight on its tail, likely would have taken off and possibly crashed into hangars or nearby homes.

### Seeing-Eye Dog Going Blind

MONCLAIR, N.J. (AP)—A 13-year-old seeing-eye dog who faithfully served his master for 12 years is himself going blind and will spend the rest of his days with nothing to do but relax.

The gentle German shepherd dog Mat, acted as the eyes for Harold Trowbridge, blind proprietor of a Monclair news store. Trowbridge removed Mat's harness Wednesday and officially retired him.

But Trowbridge won't replace his trusted friend—instead, he will use cabs or human guides to help him when he travels.

After replacing Mat, Trowbridge says, "you can't do that any more than you could just change one child for another."

Mat, who has guided his master an estimated 8000 miles, has lost the sight of his left eye. A cataract now is clouding the dog's right eye.

Trowbridge said he recently started to suspect something was wrong with Mat when "the dog didn't lead him as well as usual. He brought Mat a veterinarian who told him his pet was going blind."

Sightless since 1938, Trowbridge was at one time a press agent for Pearl White, star of the early movie serial "Perils of Pauline."

### Automobiles, Many Other Civilian Goods Face Big Production Cutback Soon

WASHINGTON, (AP)—Production of civilian items such as automobiles and refrigerators which are made largely of critical metals, will be cut sharply in 1952 because of expanding military output.

That was the emphatic warning of the nation's top mobilization chiefs yesterday. Defense mobilization Charles E. Wilson put it this way: "From now on, during 1952, there will be many more guns and much less butter."

Wilson told the national press club that manufacturers of civilian goods will get only about 50 percent of their usual amounts of three critical metals—steel, copper and aluminum—in the first quarter of next year.

And Manly Fleischmann, defense production administrator and a principal Wilson aide, disclosed at the same time that "substantial" additional cutbacks in metal quotas must be made in April, May and June.

Fleischmann explained that military officials have made big boosts in their demands for strategic metals in the second 1952 quarter.

The DPA head said he did not look for such increase in unemployment on a national scale because of the civilian cutbacks but agreed there would be more jobless in some areas.

He cited Detroit and New England particularly. There already have been sharp protests from members of congress in both these sectors about growing unemployment.

Wilson used the press club speech for a defense of the mobilization program.

He declared production of new jet planes "exceeds by many many times" the number of all kinds of planes lost in Korea. The air force has announced that aircraft losses of the United Nations

forces total nearly 900; most of these were American. "The delivery figures on jets "by no means reflect the progress we have made," Wilson said. Many new planes have been built but are undelivered because of "minor adjustments," he added. Commenting on a capitol bill charges that some military goals had not been met, the defense mobilizer said "the kind of schedule we have failed to meet is the pious hope kind."
