Controversial Diplomat Dismissed by State Dept.

WASHINGTON, (AP)—John Stewart Service, long a controversial figure in American diplomacy and a target of pro-communist charges, was fired by the state department last night. The department acted after the government's highest loyalty review board ruled there was a "reasonable doubt" as to his loyalty.

The ruling, dating back to the famous "Amerasia" case of 1945, was based on the board's finding that Service gave secret documents at that time to a magazine editor the board said Service suspected of Communist leanings or connections.

In reaching its decision, the review board reversed a finding of a state department's own loyalty security board which had been favorable to Service on the basis of the same evidence.

NO CHOICE

A state department announcement of the dismissal, which becomes effective at the close of business today, expressed no agreement with the review board's conclusion. It made clear that the department had no choice in the matter in view of that conclusion.

Service himself labeled the action as "a shock, a surprise, an injustice" and said that on the basis of his record there could be no doubt of his loyalty. He and his attorney, Charles E. Rhett, were understood to be considering whether the case, which has now run the full course of government procedures, might be taken into court.

The Amerasia case developed more than six years ago. The magazine "Amerasia" was edited given by Reverend Irvin Twest, Master of Ceremonies Floyd Wynn, introduced Coach Bob Henderson who presented each member of the squad and made the awards. Music for the occasion was furnished by the "Lions club" band.

BOAT MISSING

TOKYO, (AP)—Kyodo news agency says a 98-foot Japanese fishing boat is missing after being fired upon by an unidentified ship in the East China sea off the southern tip of Korea.

by Philip C. Jaffe of New York who became acquainted with Service after the diplomat returned home from one of his tours of duty in China.

Subsequently a number of classified government documents, chiefly from the state and navy departments, were found in the Amerasia offices. Service and four other persons were arrested on charges of conspiracy to commit espionage.

Jaffe and two others were indicted on a lesser charge—conspiracy to remove government documents illegally. The editor pleaded guilty and was fined \$2500.

CLEARED

But the other three persons, including Service, appeared before the grand jury and it refused to indict them. The diplomat then was reinstated in the foreign service from which he had been suspended.

His part in the affair, as revealed by the records of the two boards, was that in a series of meetings with Jaffe, he gave the editor to read a number of his own reports to the state department from China.

Service said in his statement last night this "involved discussing normal and proper background information with a journalist whom I believed, at the time, to be nothing more than the editor of a reputable specialist magazine dealing with the Far East."

Service, 42, has been in the diplomatic corps since 1933. He has been most sharply attacked in recent years by former Ambassador Patrick J. Hurley, who seriously questioned Service's reports from China when Hurley was U.S. envoy there, and by Sen. McCarthy (R-Wis.), who has declared that Service's record as a pro-Communist was "crystal clear."

In Los Angeles last night, McCarthy said Service "is only one of many rotten apples in the barrel."

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re. The senator renewed his demand for removal of State Secy. Dean Acheson, saying Acheson "had all the evidence on Service for many years and refused to act."

TRUMAN ORDER

State department records showed that in the past three years Service has been cleared by the department's own loyalty panel.

The notification came from the review agency's chairman, Hiram Bingham, who wrote Acheson: "The loyalty review board found no evidence of membership in the Communist party or in any organization on the attorney general's (subversive) list on the part of John Stewart Service. The loyalty review board did find that there is a reasonable doubt as to the loyalty of the employee, John Stewart Service, to the government of the United States, based on the intentional and unauthorized disclosure of documents and information of a confidential and non-public nature."
