### Clowns Show Magic In Chiloquin Sunday

Those faithful magicians of the basketball court, the hilarious Harlem Clowns (formerly the Broadway Clowns), are coming to Chiloquin Sunday to display their slight-of-hand ball handling, lightning like passing and laugh-provoking antics.

The Clowns meet the Chiloquin Townies of the Klamath Basin Independent League at 8:15.

The Klamath Boys, another KB team, faces a Chiloquin Alumni five in the 6:45 preliminary. Led by Al "Runt" Pullins, all-time all-star Harlem Globe Trotters selection, the Harlem Clowns have one of the really remarkable touring basketball teams in the United States.

**VETERANS**  
The 1951-52 edition of the Harlem Clowns basketball team is composed of four veteran members of last year's squad and three new members.

There is, of course, Pullins, all-time great of the basketball world, who is the owner and manager of the team. Al started off with the Harlem Globe Trotters back in 1929 and is still going strong. The

"Runt" holds quite a few records in basketball, including one high school mark at Chicago years ago, a season scoring record of 2582 set while with the Globetrotters and a single game scoring record of 77. Jackie (laugh-a-minute) White is back with the team. This boy is one of the best showmen in the business and fans are liable to find him most anywhere in the gymnasium during a ball-game, sometimes sitting up with the audience or running up and down the aisles.

**TOP SCORER**  
Bill Mobley, former Harlem Globe Trotters scoring ace, is playing his second season with the Clowns. Bill led the team in scoring last year with an average of 19 points a game for the season. Big Wally (The Moose) Edwards, is another veteran with the team. Edwards is six feet two inches tall and weighs 230.

But the boy to watch this season, says Mgr. Pullins, is Edward Carter, the "Schoolboy Wonder" from Chicago. Only 19 years old, six feet two and weighing 175, Carter is potentially one of the greatest basketball players in America. Every college in the country was after Carter this fall, but Pullins lured him to the Clowns.

### Sentry Test Too Much For Corporal

COPENHAGEN, Denmark, (AP)—A corporal sought to test the efficiency of a sentry at Oesterbro army barracks early today. The sentry, a champion marksman, killed the corporal with a shot fired at 60 yards in the dark.

The army gave this report: Cpl. H. Christian Jensen deliberately attracted suspicion of the sentry. The sentry challenged Jensen, who tried to escape by running away in a zig-zag course among the trees. The sentry, following regulations, challenged loudly twice, fired a warning shot and when the corporal continued to run aimed to hit.

The sentry's name was not disclosed. An army spokesman said it was "extremely improbable" that any charge would be brought against him.

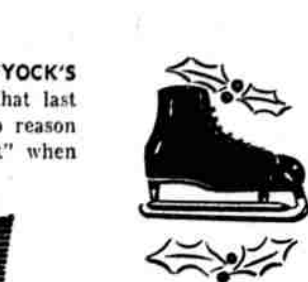
