OSC Slates Study Of Filbert Crop

PORTLAND, (P)—Oregon State college will undertake a research program on filbert nuts, Roy A. Ward told the nut growers association of Oregon and Washington yesterday.

He said the studies, to be financed by a \$2 a ton levy on all northwest filberts sold in the U.S., will include:

1. Research on ways to remove the skin from the filbert kernel.
2. Finding new uses for filberts in cheese spreads.
3. Developing use of filberts in ice cream and dairy products.
4. Determining effect of filbert enzymes on the rate of ripening cheese.

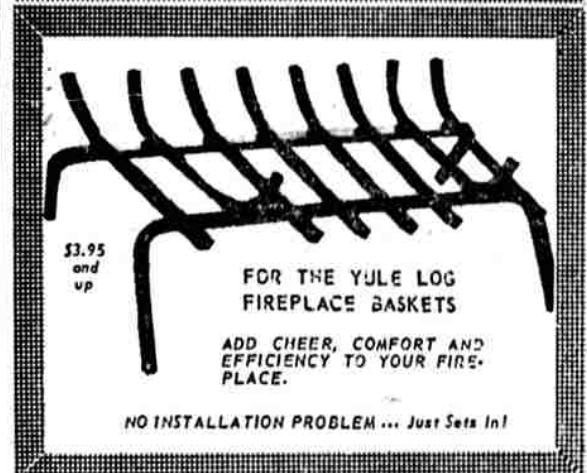
