The government has collected at least \$200,000 in gambling taxes since the new 10 per cent levy went into force two months ago, an Associated Press survey disclosed

Associated Press survey disclosed today.

That sum was paid by professional gamblers in about one-fourth of 48 states. Some collectors of internal revenue declined to make the figures public. Others said their records were quite incomplete, Still others said they collected nothing.

Congressional backers of the tax predicted it would raise 400 million dollars a year. This would average out to more than 30 million dollars a month.

Collection sums in five figures were reported in only three states—Ohlo, Florida and Indiana.

At Tacoma, Wash., the collector's office said \$14.805.42 was collected from gamblers' income by the new tax for the month of November. Some 350 returns were filed. The compiled.
