WASHINGTON 1th — Prime Minister Churchill's address to Congress Thuraday left open the question of just how much Britain could help in applying "prompt, resolute and effective" action against a violation of the proposed Korean truce.

He said Britain and the United States are agreed this would be "our" response should an armistice once arrived at, be broken.

His statement was generally accepted as referring to the original proposal of the United States that any truce should be beliwarked by an implied ultimatum that Red China would be bombed and blocked if the Communists launched a new aggression in Korea.


