### Soup Lack Denied By Official

CAMDEN, N. J. (AP) — A spokesman for one of the nation's largest food canning firms said Thursday that a recent easing of federal restrictions on tin containers should improve the supply of soups, canned foods and similar products.

Asked about a report from Seattle, that soups packed by the Campbell Soup Co. were in short supply there, a company official said he knew of no specific shortage and suggested a possibility that there might have been some temporary dislocation due to unexpected demand or possibly transportation difficulties.

However, he pointed out that a federal order issued Jan. 27, 1951, limited the metal available for canning non-seasonal soups—those kinds which can be produced at any time in the year—to 100 per cent of the amount used in 1950.

On Oct. 1, 1951, an amendment reduced the available metal to 90 per cent of the base period. The orders did not affect the so-called "seasonal" soups, such as tomato, asparagus and others which are packed at the peak of the harvest season for the ingredients.

Another federal order issued last Jan. 22 restored the 100 per cent ration. As a result, the Campbell official said, his firm and others expect to be able to meet normal demand for their products. Some temporary shortages cannot be avoided in food distribution, the official said, but usually these are local in nature and only temporary. (See story page 7)

### Stockmen OK Sales Tax

McMINNVILLE (AP) — The Western Oregon Livestock Association favors a sales tax—proceeds to go to the support of schools.

The association, which closed its 19th annual convention here Wednesday, also passed a resolution endorsing a six mill limitation on state property taxes.

Howard Leatherman, Coquille, was named president, succeeding Archie Rickola, Astoria. Roger Dumd, McMinnville, was elected vice-president; and Harry Lindgren, Oregon State College, was re-elected secretary-treasurer.

Land prices will be lower this year, Gerald Stantfield, Weiser, Idaho, president of the Oregon Wool Growers Association, predicted. He complained that the federal government had hurt the wool industry by using synthetic material and reduced wool in military uniforms.

The association also asked the Fish and Wildlife Service to consider poisoning of coyotes in Western Oregon, as is now the practice in Eastern Oregon.

Other resolutions proposed tax re-appraisal of timberlands in the state, and higher fees for dog licenses.
