Squeaky Put On Probation

PEORIA, Ill. (AP) — The Circuit Court decreed a year's probation Thursday for Gene "Squeaky" Melchiorre, former Bradley University basketball star who admitted figuring in game-fixing activities.

Melchiorre had pleaded guilty to an indictment charging failure to report a bribe to shave points from Bradley's score in a game won 77-84 from Oregon State here in December, 1950.

Three other Bradley players had admitted sharing in a \$4,000 payoff for holding down the score but Melchiorre was the only one indicted.

Ducks Host Huskies; Cougars, Idaho Clash

 Oregon's Webfoots get their home floor crack at the University of Washington Huskies this weekend while Idaho and Washington State put on one of their basketball throat-cutting parties in the Northwest Division of the Pacific Coast Conference.

Draining a league bye but far from idle, Oregon State's Beavers will be Friday-Saturday hosts to Bradley, one of the Midwest's best.

The last double wrangle between Idaho and Washington State found each the victor on its home floor. Idaho desperately needs a clean sweep of this series to stick to the heels of Washington, which it trails by a full game in the standings.

Friday night's fracas will be in Pullman, with the teams switching to Idaho's home camp in Moscow Saturday.

The front-running Huskies, ninth ranked nationally, will be at full strength for their brush in Eugene against a team very anxious to square accounts. Oregon was leading the loon when the clubs clashed earlier in Seattle and a twin defeat knocked the Webfoots off the perch.

Oregon's main trouble in the first series was a basket as lightly closed as a boarding house garbage can. It finished up with a shooting percentage of about 15 per cent each evening. On the home floor the Eugene five should be much sharper.

Williams Undecided

NEW YORK (AP) — Ted Williams' future in baseball still is as hazy to him as it is to everyone else.

The Boston Red Sox slugger, en route to Boston where he will appear in a sportsman's show, said Friday nothing definite has been decided as to whether he will take part in spring practice or appear in early-season games prior to his physical examination for return to service as a captain in the Marine Air Corps.

"Any speculation as to my future in baseball after my service is pure speculation and not worth the breath," he added.

Williams, should he pass the physical April 2, will report May 2 for active duty.

Kansas State Faces Loss of Two Cagers

MANHATTAN, Kas. (AP) — Kansas State, which has been booming in basketball on a combination of excellent coaching and good recruiting, may lose a couple of its latest finds.

The Kansas State Athletic Council Thursday declared ineligible two former Omaha high school players following a protest by the University of Nebraska. Nebraska said the boys had been recruited illegally.

The players were identified as Stanley Schaezle and David Bell. Kansas State is rated No. 2 nationally in the Associated Press poll and leads the Big Seven Conference with four victories and no losses.

Dr. H. H. Haymaker, a member of the Kansas State Athletic Council and the school's representative on the Big Seven Conference's rules-making faculty committee, said the two boys were ruled ineligible last Monday and would remain that way until the faculty group meets in Kansas City Feb. 29-March 1.

The specific charge was that Kansas State violated a new Big Seven rule which prohibits "personal solicitation of athletes off the campus by members of the athletic staff or representatives of the athletic staff."

Nebraska Coach Harry Good charged the two young players were invited to attend the Kansas State-Iowa State game Jan. 19 in Manhattan and that they were given basketball tryouts.
