Senator Sees War Gamble

WASHINGTON (AP)—Sen. O'Mahoney D-Wyo., said Tuesday that top Pentagon leaders are gambling that Soviet Russia will not touch off another world war "until 1954 or 1955."

"I want to be more certain that meanwhile we have a defense program that allows us to keep up with the Russians in air power," O'Mahoney told a reporter.

He offered these comments as he asked Secretary of Defense Lovett and the Army, Navy and Air Force Secretaries to return for a second day of public testimony on the \$52,100,000,000 military budget for the next fiscal year starting July 1.

O'Mahoney is chairman of the Appropriations subcommittee handling the huge spending bill.

Lovett made it plain Monday that the multi-billion dollar defense program is far short of the totals asked by the military chiefs.

He also testified that original goals for production of aircraft, tanks and other military "hard goods" had been cut back sharply.

The secretary said that in preparing "against the dangers of a hot war, we must not be trapped by our own efforts into losing the cold one."

"We have tried to eliminate the fat as far as possible," he said. "I am fearful that we have cut into the muscle in some places."

O'Mahoney said the gamble that Russia does not plan an immediate war was evident in Lovett's testimony about production of aircraft for the Air Force and Navy.

The senator said the present schedule calls for deliveries through 1954 and into 1955.

LONDON (AP)—Foreign Secretary Anthony Eden angrily accused some laborites Tuesday night of "anti-American prejudice" during a debate over British and American policies in Korea.

In an uproarious scene in the House of Commons, Eden outlined Britain's position in case a Korean truce is made and then broken.

The Foreign Secretary also declared stoutly that "the American government and people are as deeply anxious for peace in the Far East as we are ourselves."

The normally imperturbable Eden at one point clenched both fists, pounded the table and cried: "There is in some quarters such anti-American prejudice that they will hardly listen to what I say."

Eden's interruptions came mostly from Left Wing Laborites. Eden said he and Prime Minister Winston Churchill had made no new commitments when they talked with President Truman in Washington.

Then Eden gave his reply as to what would happen if Communists break a Korean truce: "The only undertaking, if it can be so described, which we have entered into is that, in that event,

consultation would take place among the interested parties including ourselves."

Left Wing Laborites have been asserting Britain has secretly

agreed with the United States to retaliate against the Communist Chinese mainland if the truce is broken. They have asserted this would start World War Three.

Acheson Tells About Ransom

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Senate Armed Services Committee Tuesday got a hush-hush report from Secretary of State Acheson on why the United States decided to pay Hungary \$120,000 for the release of four American fliers.

The committee heard Acheson behind closed doors. Sen. Lyndon Johnson, D-Tex., the acting chairman, said afterwards the members would "no doubt give consideration to the information provided."

Johnson added that the committee had decided not to make public any of that information at this time.

"We got from Acheson his story of what happened and a somewhat

detailed report of each move by the State Department leading to the release of these men," Johnson told reporters.

Another member who asked not to be named described the situation as "delicate" and said publicity could have a harmful effect. In reply to questions, he said there had been some discussion of what might happen if a similar case were to develop in the future.

In advance of Tuesday's meeting of the committee, Sen. Morse R-Ore., a member, said he wanted to ask Acheson about the reasons for the decision to pay and what alternatives were considered.

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Defense Department Wednesday identified 40 more battle casualties in Korea in a new list (No. 495) that reported 12 killed, 26 wounded, one missing and one injured. It also listed two dead who were previously carried as missing.
