Try the recipe below. The cookies are made in the size of the cereal ingredient gives a very chewy texture to the cookie—making a sweet he can really get his teeth into. Raisins add a nutritive and flavor plus.

SWEETHEART DAY COOKIES

- 2 1/2 cup shortening
- 1 3/3 cups brown sugar
- 3 eggs, well beaten

- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 1/2 cups seedless raisins
- 2 cups sifted flour
- 3 cups baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon mace
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 cup bran flakes

Blend shortening and sugar; add eggs, milk and raisins. Beat well. Sift flour with baking powder, salt and spices. Add to shortening mixture with bran flakes; mix well. Drop by spoonfuls onto greased baking sheet. Bake in moderate oven (375 F.) about 15 minutes. Yield: 5 1/2 dozen cookies, 2 inches in diameter.

QUICKIE

Never was there a quicker and easier candy to make than coconut twigs. Heat one package of sweet chocolate over boiling water until partly melted. Remove from boiling water and stir rapidly until entirely smooth. Add one cup shredded coconut and mix well. Drop from teaspoon on wax paper, cool until firm. Makes 15 delicious pieces.

Glasses Need Care To Be Crystal Clear

China, earthenware, pottery, glass, plastic, copper, silver, aluminum. Plates and cups, mugs and glasses—how many materials are represented in your china and glassware cabinet?

Nothing is more luxurious or shows more painstaking care than beautifully polished glassware. Nothing looks worse when it lacks care. Thoroughly cleaned, shiny glasses are the only ones that are really pleasant to drink from—especially when it's sparkling clear water, beer or cider that fills them.

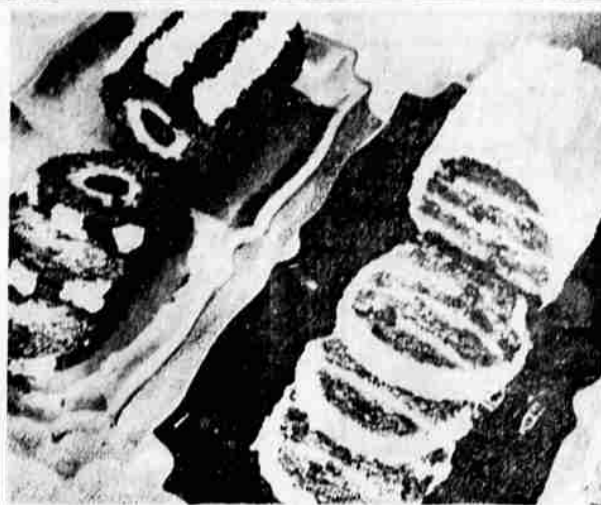
Most of us, these days, use the new way to wash dishes. Detergents and hot water make it an easy and efficient job. But glasses—like silver—need a little extra care.

If your glassware is on display, you want it to look its very best. Also, when you serve beer, you have two reasons for giving it added attention. You'll want these to sparkle, too. But beer is not at its heady best unless the glass is crystal clean—in fact, an imperceptible oily film on the glass can quickly kill the typical foamy head. So, when shiny cleanliness counts, use this technique:

Wash the glasses in hot water and detergent. Rinse thoroughly. If streaking is a real problem, sprinkle a little baking soda in each glass before rinsing. Dry thoroughly with a sparkling clean linen or linen-and-cotton dish cloth. Your glasses will sparkle like never before and your beer will taste better than ever before.

TRY THIS

Here's an interesting innovation for gingerbread lovers: When baked, remove hot from oven, cool slightly, cut in two layers. Spread a layer of raspberry jam over bottom section, cover this with a layer of cottage cheese. Place the other layer of gingerbread on top. Cut in squares and serve with a topping of whipped cream if desired.



SANDWICH LOAVES

Tasty Sandwich Loaves For Valentine Parties

Would you like to impress the bridge club . . . or the meeting of women voters at your house? Well, we all know that this calls for something pretty special and we have that something for you today.

It's a sandwich loaf—made from a homemade bran bread that is baked in a can. It has all the appearance and taste-flavor of popular Boston steamed brown bread but we've added a modern touch. Our bread is baked rather than steamed—and in just 45 minutes. The recipe will make enough dough to fill two cans (baked bean size.)

Take one loaf and cut bran bread into 4 slices horizontally. For the first slice, combine 1 chopped hard cooked egg, a large grated carrot, 1 stalk celery, chopped, 1/2 teaspoon each salt and pepper, 2 drops tabasco sauce and 1 tablespoon mayonnaise. Cover second slice with pimiento cheese spread. For

the third, chop 1/4 inch slice of canned luncheon meat into very fine pieces. Combine with 2 teaspoons India relish and 1 tablespoon mayonnaise. Put fourth slice on top. Chill.

Just before serving, frost loaf with softened cream cheese which has been seasoned with salt and pepper and beaten until light with about 1 tablespoon milk. With the second loaf, starting at one end and using a sharp knife, make a circular cut halfway through center. Turn the loaf over and beginning at the other end, repeat the procedure until the two cuts meet.

Remove the center with an apple corer. Fill cavity with a cheese spread, such as pimiento, and then insert small sweet pickles end-to-end in center. Spread top with softened cream cheese. For variation, fill cavity with a baked bean filling. Mash 1/2 cup baked beans with a fork. Combine with 1/4 teaspoon salt, 1 1/2 tablespoons chili sauce, 1 tablespoon mayonnaise.

Molasses Bran Brown Bread
1 cup ready-to-eat bran
1/2 cup seedless raisins
2 tablespoons shortening
1/2 cup New Orleans molasses
1 cup hot water
1 egg
1 cup sifted flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon (if desired)

Measure bran, raisins, shortening and molasses into mixing bowl. Add hot water, stirring until shortening is melted. Add egg and beat well. Sift together flour, soda, salt, and cinnamon; add to bran mixture. Stir only until combined. Fill 2 greased cans (baked bean cans, 4 1/2 inches deep, 2 1/2 inches across) about 2/3 full; or spread in greased loaf pan (9 1/2 x 4 1/2 inches). Bake in moderate oven (350 F.) about 45 minutes for canned bread or about 35 minutes for loaf bread. Remove from cans or pan, slice and serve hot.

If you use one of the modern "improved" lards you may keep it on your kitchen cupboard shelf; it does not need to be refrigerated.

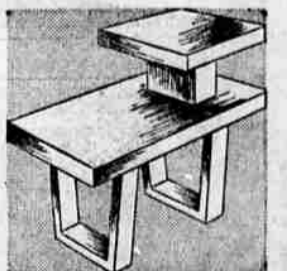

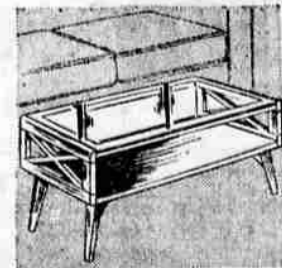
