New Angling Laws Applied

Angling regulations adopted by the game commission on January 25 are now in effect. The new winter regulations apply at present and will remain in force until March 16 in Zone 1, April 18 in Zone 2, and May 2 in eastern Oregon.

In Zones 1 and 2 which include all of western Oregon except the Umpqua and Rogue systems, the winter bag limit is two fish per day and four per week, 12 inches or over, embracing any combination of trout, jack salmon, steel-head or salmon.

tion of trout, jack salmon, steel-head or salmon.

In eastern Oregon the winter bag limit is two steelhead or salmon 20 inches: and over per day or four such fish per week.

On the Umpqua and Rogue sys-tems the winter regulations now applying are identical to those of last year.

Of interest is the fact that the practice of listing waters open to winter angling as has been done for several years in Zone 1 (coast) has been adopted for Zone 2 and all of the eastern part of the state. Streams or lakes which names do not appear on the listings are closed entirely to winter angling. Until the 1952 synopsis is available in March, the February bulletin of the game commission should be used for reference. Winter angling waters are listed by zone in that bulletin on pages 11 and 12. Anglers must continue to use the 1951 steelhead-salmon tag card until it is replaced by the 1952 punch card which will become effective on March 18.
