Worst News Found By Wife

INGLEWOOD, Calif. (AP) - Mrs. Peggy Paulsen, a widow at 19, Thursday found her worst fears confirmed when the coffin of her husband, slain in Korea, was opened as she prayed in a nearby room.

Mrs. Paulsen was hoping against hope that conflicting stories of how her husband, Robert, 21, was killed in Korea, Sept. 2, were all wrong.

She had asked that the casket be opened, "just to be sure it's him."

"I'm satisfied it's Bob," a cousin, Robert Wine, told her as he came from the room at a local mortuary where Robert's body lay.

"Oh God! They killed him. They killed him," she gasped, then fell into the arms of her dead husband's brother.

As others made funeral plans, Mrs. Paulsen left, clinging to her infant daughter born five days before Pvt. Paulsen was killed.

Mrs. Roy L. Guack, president of Calvary Baptist WMU will have charge of the observance.

Revolution Said Backed By Book

TOKYO (AP) - The Nippon Times reported Friday the outline for a Communist revolution in Japan is being circulated in a booklet entitled "How to Raise Power Bulbs."

The newspaper said the pamphlet proposes that revolutionaries arm themselves by stealing weapons from occupation forces and Japanese police.

The Times said the movement would be financed by stealing goods from occupation forces and reselling them.

Douglas Protests Name On Ballot

PORTLAND (AP) - Monroe Sweetland, Democratic national committeeman for Oregon, said Thursday night that William O. Douglas does not want his name on the Oregon presidential primary ballot.

Douglas told him that he is writing to the Oregon secretary of state, asking that his name be kept off the ballot. Sweetland said.

Earlier, Douglas, associate justice of the U.S. Supreme Court, declared he was not a candidate. Nevertheless petitions to put him on the Democratic ballot went into circulation in Oregon last week.

During the Lenten season Rev. Anderson has scheduled special services at Sunday morning services with special topics for Sunday evening Christian Way of Life classes at 7:30 p.m. and Wednesday evening services at 8 p.m.

Battle Rages Over Meeting

GRANTS PASS (AP) - A Jehovah's Witnesses meeting opens in the armory here Friday over the protest of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

The V. F. W. carried its protest to the governor and the adjutant general, but those officials said they would not enter the controversy.

A spokesman in Salem explained armory rentals were left to local officers under a policy that there would be no discrimination as to race or creed.

The rental agreement for the armory was signed about two months ago by Major Don Burke, battalion commander for the National Guard in Southern Oregon.

The Jehovah's Witnesses meeting is scheduled through Saturday and Sunday. The V. F. W. protested that the sect had been involved in court cases for refusal to salute the U.S. flag.

Senator Sued By Cab Driver

PORTLAND (AP) - Police arrested State Sen. Thomas R. Mahoney of Portland on an assault and battery complaint Thursday. He was freed on \$50 bond.

An Oregon City taxicab driver, Wayne Hull, signed the complaint against Mahoney, accusing the state senator of knocking money out of his hand and pushing him in front of the Oregon City Elks Club Wednesday night.

Mahoney insisted he was innocent. He said the taxicab driver mistook him for a man who had called a cab.

"The taxi driver grabbed me by the arm and insisted he was entitled to a fee. I only exerted sufficient force to cause him to release me," Mahoney said.
