## High Speed Printer Built

NEW YORK (AP)—A high-speed printer which combines electronics and dry photographic techniques to produce 10,000 characters a second was described Thursday at the Institute of Radio Engineers. J. T. McNamey, a senior electronics engineer for Consolidated Vultee Aircraft Corp., San Diego, Calif., explained the process. McNamey is inventor of the Charactertron, a special purpose cathode-ray tube, which is utilized in the printer. He said the tube would be of value in many applications requiring high-speed visual presentation of information on a direct viewing screen or for a permanent record on ordinary newspaper or other low-cost media. Through use of the Charactertron tube it produces a printing speed of 20 inches of paper per second. McNamey told the engineers he believed the Xerography process, developed by the Haloid Company of Rochester, N. Y., would be ideally suited for use in connection with his tube as a means of recording.

## DIES

NICE, France (AP)—The last survivor of Monday's crash of an Air France airliner died here Thursday. She was French dancer Marguerite Delphy, who succumbed to injuries received in the crash. Of 37 others aboard, 36 were killed outright when the plane crashed in an olive grove near here and a woman passenger died en route to the hospital.
