Buying Sessions Boosts All Grains

Chicago (AP)—A strong buying movement late in the session took hold of the grain market Monday and left all cereals higher. Most contracts ended at the day's peaks, made in the last few minutes of dealing.

It was the sixth straight day of advancing quotations for corn and oats. They were aided by smaller cash corn receipts at major terminals than either a week or year ago. Wheat, after lagging most of the day, came ahead sharply toward the close on short-covering.

Wheat closed 1-1/4 higher, Mar. \$2.54 1/2, corn 1-1/4 higher, Mar. \$1.82 1/2, oats 1/4 higher, Mar. \$1.14 1/2, soybeans 1-1/4 higher, May \$3.04 1/2, soybeans 1-3/4 higher, cents a hundred pounds higher, Mar. \$11.90.
