

### FBI Quizzes Woman In Theft Case

MILWAUKEE (AP) — Andrew Robert Young, 46, an ex-convict, was seized by FBI agents Tuesday in connection with the theft of 1 1/2 million dollars from the home of a Reno, Nev., millionaire 10 days ago.

The agents seized Young after tracing him, they said, through an attractive dark-haired mystery woman who attempted to pass a \$1,000 bill at a Reno gambling table.

After hours of questioning, during which Young denied taking part in the Feb. 29 burglary or even being in Reno at the time, he was brought before U.S. Commissioner Floyd B. Jenkins. Preliminary transportation of stolen property was adjourned for a week pending hearing on a charge of interstate arrival of a warrant from Reno. Young was held in jail in \$50,000 bond.

U. S. Attorney Timothy T. Cronin said Nevada authorities told him Young was charged there with being involved in the burglary of the mansion of Laverne V. Redfield. Whether others were involved, federal authorities refused to say. The FBI men who arrested Young said they found five \$100 bills on him but none of the rest of the cash, securities and jewelry taken from the Reno millionaire's home.

The mystery woman in Reno was questioned by FBI men Monday night after she attempted to break a \$1,000 bill after losing at the Riverside Hotel gambling casino. The casino cashiers identified the bill by its serial number as part of the loot taken in the Redfield burglary.

### Resuscitator Used In Local Case

### US Papers Widely Read

PHILADELPHIA — The combined circulation of English-language newspapers in the United States last year totaled 53,565,900. The figure, printed in the 4th annual edition of N. W. Ayer & Son's directory of newspapers and periodicals, nearly equals the all-time record established in 1950.

The annual directory published by the advertising firm pointed out that, despite newspaper shortages, evening newspapers last year had daily circulation totalling 32,225,000—highest ever recorded.

The combined daily circulation of morning papers was 20,457,000, while the nation's three all-day dailies had a combined circulation of 911,000.

Sunday newspapers at the end of 1951 had a circulation of 45,907,000. Sunday papers since the end of World War II have added 19

### Meat, Milk Supply Falls

CINCINNATI, (AP) — A Cornell university educator said Wednesday that the supply of milk and meat in this country isn't keeping pace with the increasing population.

Dr. Herrell DeGraff of Cornell's School of Nutrition noted that the population is rising at the rate of 2,500,000 persons a year. He stated, "meat consumption per capita was 17 pounds (11 per cent) less in 1951 than in 1947, and milk consumption, expressed as total milk equivalent, was down last year 70 pounds (nine per cent) from the post-war high in 1946.

DeGraff spoke at the seventh annual conference of the Distillers Feed Research Council. C. M. Ely, research scientist here with the National Distillers Products Corp., said that chickens grow faster and fatter when a laundering detergent is sprinkled in their feed — but the experts don't know why.
