Bridges In News Again; Case Eyed

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — A government attorney conceded in court Tuesday that he had "grave doubts" about legality of Harry Bridges' perjury conviction. But he argued that the conspiracy conviction of the longshore leader should be upheld. Robert B. McMillan, chief assistant United States attorney, told the U.S. Court of Appeals his doubts were based on a ruling by a New York court in a similar case. That case affected Michael Obermeier, a labor leader, who, like Bridges, was convicted of falsely

denying he had been a Communist at naturalization proceedings. A New York appeals court held that a three-year statute of limitations knocked out the case. The government had argued at Bridges' trial that a five-year statute of limitations applied. Bridges was convicted in April, 1950, along with two top aides in the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's union, Henry Schmidt and J. R. Robertson. He received a five-year sentence, the two co-defendants, two years each. Attorney Vincent Hallinan, who is scheduled to begin a six-month contempt sentence Wednesday, Richard Gladstein, and Norman Leonard argued that the statute of limitations had expired before Bridges was indicted; that he was persecuted by "powerful interests;" and that the trial judge, George B. Harris, was prejudiced. Hallinan, who clashed bitterly with Harris during the lengthy trial, was denied a stay of execution or a reduction in the contempt sentence by Judge Harris.
