

Bees Prove To Be A Case Of Hot Weather Workers

CORVALLIS (AP) — The trouble with the busy little bee is that it gets lazy in cool weather. Won't work until mid-morning. Won't work in a strong wind. Jefferson County which needs busy little bees has, it turns out, quite an assortment of lazy little bees.

This report on the bee, widely acclaimed for its industrious habits, comes from Dr. H. A. Scullen, apiculturist for the Oregon State College Experiment Station. An apiculturist is one who knows about bee keeping.

And what Dr. Scullen knows is this: Weather pretty much determines the full work habits of the bee. A Jefferson County survey shows that until the temperature gets up to 70 degrees bees won't work.

That means that cool Jefferson County needs more bees than would a warm region, to pollinate their seed crops. More than 20,000 bee colonies were used last year in that county and the number wasn't enough. Other counties where warm temperatures aren't common in the mornings during the spring also probably need more bees he reported.

Military Backs Up State Department In Demands For Propaganda Outlay

WASHINGTON (AP) — The State Department had military support Wednesday in urging that this country wage an all-out war of ideas against the Communists and a "sinister" hate-American campaign.

"We can not do the job half-way," Gen. J. Lawton Collins, Army chief of staff, told a House Appropriations subcommittee. "We must go all out in the battle of ideas. Only thus can we hope to convince potential aggressors that another war can not pay."

The committee released testimony supporting a 170-million-dollar State Department request for its overseas "campaign for truth" for the next fiscal year, starting July 1. That amount is double the \$85 million dollars Congress approved last year.

State Department witnesses ran into sharp questioning from committee members critical of the size of the request.

Planes Blast Red Houses
 SEOUL, Korea (AP) — U.S. F-84 Thunderjets Wednesday destroyed 18 buildings and six troop rearmenents just east of Kaesong — headquarters for Communist armistice negotiators.

The Fifth Air Force said the Red emplacements were outside the area designated as neutral during the truce talks.

American pilots reported 12 enemy troops killed in the air assault.

Other Allied warplanes continued to pound battered Red rail supply lines throughout north Korea despite low clouds and hazy weather.

On the ground, a company-size Communist assault was thrown back on the Western front in an hour skirmish. Three other probes on the Western and Central fronts in early morning darkness were turned back.

Allied artillery Tuesday killed or wounded 200 Red troops northeast of the Panmunjom truce site.

Chambers Up Before Jury
 NEW YORK (AP) — A surprise federal grand jury appearance by Whittaker Chambers has set off reports of a new spy inquiry.

Chambers, one-time Communist against Alger Hiss, was closeted with the jury for 80 minutes Tuesday.

He wouldn't say afterwards what it was about except for "matters which were familiar to me."

Reports that a new espionage probe was underway could not be confirmed and U. S. Attorney Myles J. Lane would not comment.

Chambers testified at the Hiss trial that the former State Department aid gave him departmental secrets for a prewar Soviet spy ring.

Hiss, convicted of perjury for denying Chambers' story, is serving a five-year federal prison term, but has petitioned for a new trial.
