### Quilts Smart Women Like

The "quilted fashion" is expected to hit a new high, carrying over from spring into summer! This fashion has really "caught on"—women like it! It was not designed only for cold weather—a survey shows that women prefer it in the south even in warm weather. Quilted dresses, jackets, and vests are designed for every occasion—sports, afternoon and evening wear. Capes, coats and evening wraps are being added to many of the spring and summer lines. You can find just about any combination of fabrics in this fashion that you want. It gained popularity in the cotton field, but now you can find crisp silks and rayons

too, in every solid shade of the rainbow. Some are printed, the gold printed designs proving very popular. You'll find glistening white quilted skirts studded with brilliants and some with an added painted or embroidered decorative design. In making a quilted fabric, a filling called "bating" is placed between two separate and distinct fabrics. It is held in place by a quilting thread. The quilt stitching may be in a variety of patterns or designs, but it is done for one purpose . . . to achieve that "puffed" look. To maintain the resilience of the bating . . . to retail that quilted effect . . . have your garment cleaned and finished by a professional cleaner. Modern steam-air finishing equipment is so designed that the fabric can be steamed and finished without the use of pressure. Home pressing will flatten the fabric and destroy the appearance you liked when you bought the garment.

### TUNA TIPS

Here's still another way to serve the ever-popular creamed tuna. Cut off the tops of hamburger buns or French rolls. Remove the crumbs, brush the inside and outside of the roll with melted butter and brown in the oven. Fill with creamed tuna and top with grated cheese.

When you oil a sewing machine run it a few moments to work the oil into the bearings, then wipe off the superfluous oil. Put the machine away, then run it again and wipe off the oil just before using it the next time you take it out.

**Cottage Cheese Celery Sticks**  
1 1/2 cups cottage cheese  
2 Tbsp. cream  
Paprika  
1 tsp. salt  
2 tsp. onion juice  
1 cup chopped green pepper  
Celery  
Combine all ingredients except celery. Clean celery stalks and fill cavity with mixture. Cut in 3 inch pieces and serve.

1-3 cups mayonnaise  
2 Tbsp. sugar  
1 cup diced pineapple  
1 cup diced, peeled orange  
1/2 cup chopped maraschino cherries  
2 Tbsp. cherry juice  
1-3 cup chopped nuts

Sieve cottage cheese. Combine with mayonnaise and sugar and stir until well blended. Fold in fruit, cherry juice and nuts. Freeze in refrigerator tray at coldest temperature until solid. Slice and serve on lettuce.

**Cottage Cole Slaw**  
3 cups shredded cabbage  
1 cup well-drained cottage cheese  
1 cup shredded raw carrot  
1 cup diced green pepper  
1 tsp. minced onion  
1/2 cup mayonnaise  
1 Tbsp. cider vinegar  
1 tsp. sugar  
Salt and pepper to taste.

Shred cabbage fine. Add cheese, carrot, green pepper and onion. Add to mayonnaise the vinegar, sugar, salt and pepper to taste, and thin to desired consistency with cream. Toss together lightly with cabbage mixture until the ingredients are well blended. Dust with paprika and serve.

### TUNA TIPS

For a hot "sandwich" combine leftover cooked peas and cut-up asparagus in a thin cream sauce. Arrange pieces of bite-size tuna on hot toast and spoon on hot creamed vegetables.

### Enjoy TUNA ROLL-UPS

This delicious Lenten Dish was developed by Betty Crocker's Staff at General Mills

Preheat oven to 450°. Sift together 2 cups sifted GOLD MEDAL Flour, 1 1/2 tsp. double-action baking powder, 1/2 tsp. salt. Pour into a measuring cup (but don't stir together) 1/2 cup WESSON OIL, 1/2 cup milk. Then pour all at once into the flour. Stir with fork until mixture cleans side of bowl and rounds up into a ball. Smooth by kneading dough about 10 times without additional flour. Place the dough between 2 sheets waxed paper (12 in. square).

Roll out until dough reaches edges of paper. Peel off top paper. Cut dough into 9 squares. Make tuna filling: flake 1 can (1 cup) WHITE STAR Brand TUNA, mix together with 1/2 cup minced celery, 1 egg, unbeaten. Spread 2 tsp. tuna filling over each square. Roll up each square as for jelly roll.

Place roll-ups, sealed side down, on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 10 to 15 minutes in hot oven (450°). Serve with hot sauce made by bringing to a boil (over low heat, stirring constantly) one 10 1/2-oz. can condensed cream of mushroom, celery or chicken soup and 2 tsp. chopped parsley. Garnish with parsley or paprika. Serves 6 to 9.

\*If you use GOLD MEDAL Self-Rising Flour (sold in the South), omit baking powder and salt.
