

Klamath Gets TV Channel

WASHINGTON (AP)—The long television "freeze" is over and Oregon has been allotted 33 TV channels.

The assignments, announced Sunday by the Federal Communications Commission, include 12 channels of very high frequencies (VHF) and 21 of ultra high frequencies (UHF).

The VHF channels now are in general use throughout the nation. The UHF channels are being opened for commercial use for the first time and four UHF Oregon outlets are being reserved for educational non-commercial programs.

Five applications have been filed for the Oregon Commercial channels. In the city by city assignment table which follows, VHF channels are numbered 2 through 13 and UHF channels are numbered 14 through 33. An "x" before a channel indicates that channel is reserved for educational use.

Hospital Blast Kills Mother

NEW YORK (AP)—A young mother was killed by a freak anesthetic explosion as she lay on an operating table after giving birth to her third daughter.

The explosion knocked an attending doctor unconscious. But the child, delivered by caesarean section, had been taken from the operating room and was not harmed.

He said the blast apparently was set off by a spark of static electricity acting on the anesthetic, highly-volatile cyclopropane. The cyclopropane was used, Dinin explained, since the patient's blood pressure was low. Another anesthetic might have lowered the pressure further, he added, but not the cyclopropane. Dinin said the explosion was the first of its kind in his experience and in the history of the hospital. He declined to name the attending physicians but said an investigation is under way. The dead woman was identified as 39-year-old Mrs. Raffellina Mantra, wife of a Brooklyn Navy Yard laborer. The county medical examiner said the specific cause of death was hemorrhage of the lungs.

26 Cars Start Economy Test

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Twenty-six stock models of American automobiles left here Monday on an arduous 1,415-mile, three-day drive to Sun Valley, Ida., in the annual Mobilgas Economy Run.

The cars are competing in their price groups for economy of gasoline consumption.

They will be driven at altitudes ranging from 70 feet below sea level to 8,010 feet above.

The first lap of the event, supervised by the American Automobile Association, is Arizona's Grand Canyon, 515 miles and 14 hours away.

The second lap is from the canyon, 575 miles and 14 hours, to Salt Lake City.

Wednesday's trip into Sun Valley will cover 435 miles in eight hours.

Besides a driver and relief driver each car carries a passenger and an AAA observer.

The observers are Caltech engineering students. The cars must average at least 40.4 miles per hour driving time.

Refueling stops are Blythe, Calif., Williams and Marble Canyon, Ariz.
