

Farm Ceiling Hearing Set At The Dalles

A public hearing on agricultural wage rate in Wasco County has been scheduled for 10:30 a.m. Friday in The Dalles City Hall, Chairman Leo Kotin of the Regional Wage Stabilization Board has announced.

The Agricultural Wage Committee will hold the hearings, requested by several growers in that area.

According to a report released by the board, persons in nearby areas who may be affected by a determination covering ceilings on wages are invited to appear.

The hearings are being held to establish the need for area ceiling wage rates for agricultural labor in the area, worker output, and past wage rates. Also the farm crops, farm operations and farm areas to be covered will also be checked.

A Regional Wage Stabilization Board, according to law, may make a determination if self-administered wage increased under General Wage Regulation No. 11 are not large enough to attract or retain a necessary labor force.

Spring Fair Set Next Week

The Klamath County 4-H Spring Fair is all set for April 24-25-26. The annual fair is held so 4-H boys and girls may exhibit their year's work in cooking, sewing, knitting, homemaking, camp cooking, crafts, forestry and electricity.

Baking contests, sewing contests, demonstrations and judging contests are also scheduled. Friday evening's exhibit will be topped off with a talent show set for 7:30, and Saturday night's climax will be a style show where 4-H girls model the clothing they have designed and made.

The public is invited. There is no admission.

Porter DHIA Herd Testor

U. B. "Tex" Porter has been named tester for the Klamath County Dairy Herd Improvement Association, and this week began his first rounds in testing some 22 Klamath milk shed dairy herds.

Porter's schedule calls for 29 working days. He checks more than 1000 head of dairy cattle, has a traveling laboratory in a trailer which he takes right along with him on his test trips.

The Klamath milk shed covers an area as far south as the Yreka country, and some of the herds require two days for testing.

UP Awards Go To 13

Thirteen Oregon boys and girls will receive \$100 scholarships from the Union Pacific railroad, L. J. Allen, state 4-H leader at Oregon State college, has announced.

The awards are made annually to one 4-H club member in each county served by the Union Pacific. Named the Carl Raymond Gray scholarships in honor of the late UP president, they are offered in seven western states to encourage outstanding young people to study home economics and agriculture.

The winners are high school juniors and seniors, chosen on the basis of their 4-H club work, scholarship, and school and community activities. They will receive the scholarships after successfully completing their first half-term at college.
